Everyone is cordially invited to come out and "Cheer the Braves on to victory" Friday night at Alcorn Central.

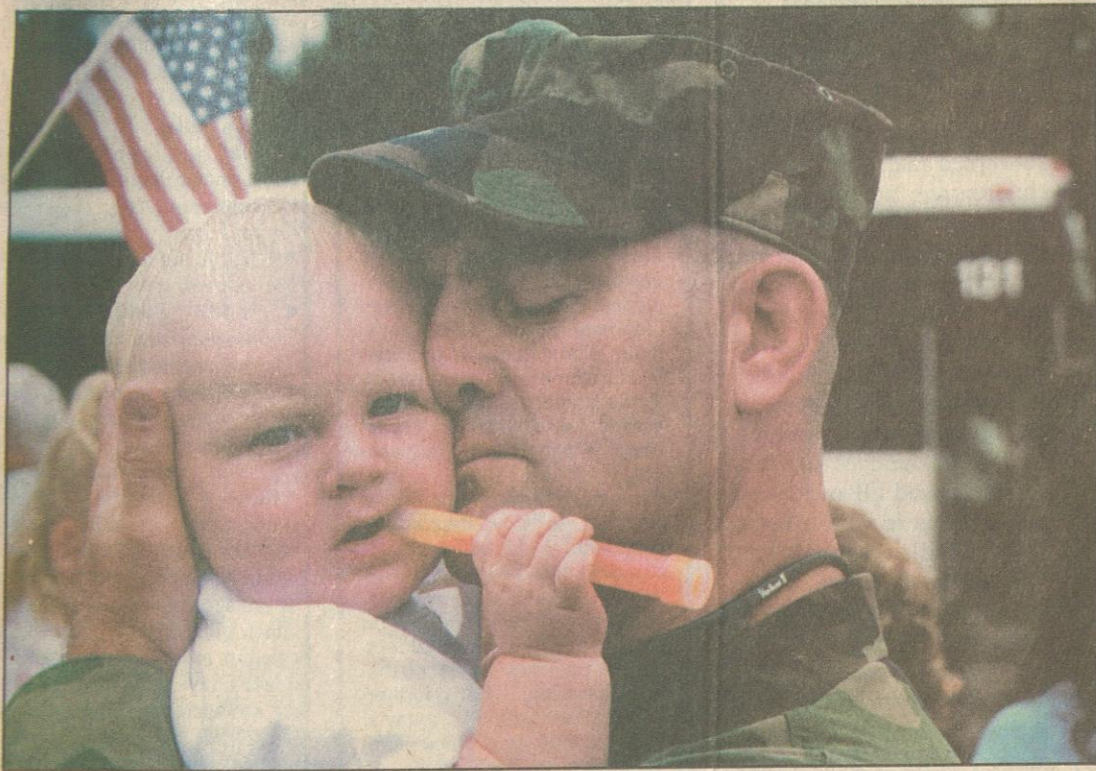

Special entertainment will start on Friday night at 6:00 p.m. with Wayne Miller and band, Jason Murphy and the

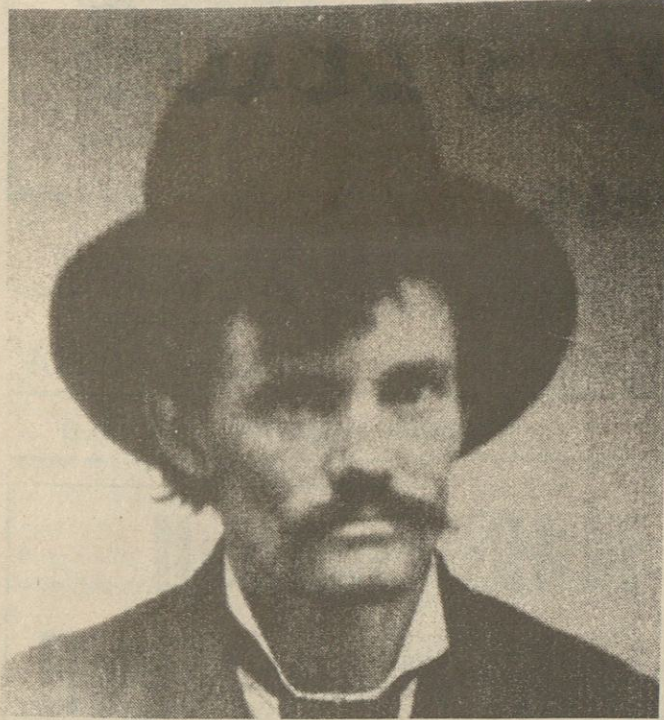
Bull Head Band, followed by Mark Pyle and Bryan Morrison with the Messenger Band.

The Wesley Busby Legacy



John Wesley Busby was born March 21, 1851 at the junction of Indian Creek and the Tennessee River in Tishomingo County, Mississippi. He was the sixth child of Robert and Sarah Adeline Caroline Turner Busby. Robert owned over 1,000 acres of land in the Tennessee River and Indian Creek area. This land was originally owned by Chickasaw Indian Ish-tul-la-cha.

Wesley had red hair and was of medium build. He had a normal childhood on a Tennessee River bottom farm. He attended local schools in the area. In 1858 he was attending a school taught by Odom C. Nelson. With the beginning of the Civil War things would change for Wesley. The Busbys did not believe in slavery but were sympathetic to the southern cause. Robert named his youngest son Robert Jefferson Davis Busby. Eastport only four miles east was a strategic boat landing site. It was said to be the best landing place on the river. Both the Union and Confederate armies were in this area. Wesley and his older brother James Newbern would hide the mules and milk cows in a steep hollow from Union marauders. Sometimes the boys would spend the night in the hollow with the farm animals. Because of the strategic location, the Confederate army used the hollow to hide ammunition and supplies from the Union army. This hollow became known as Camp Hollow.

At 1 p.m. on April 2, 1862 the Union gunboat Cairo started shelling the Camp Hollow and the Confederate battery above the mouth of Indian Creek. The Busby women were washing clothes when the barrage started. One cannonball landed close to the women but did not explode. This cannonball still exists today.

Sometime after the shelling, Wesley and Newb found a cannonball that still had powder in it. They built a fire under the cannonball.

daughter of Daniel and Selina Medley Dexter. The Dexter family lived about 3 miles up Indian Creek from the Busby family.

Wesley and Rebecca built a large wood frame house at the mouth of Camp Hollow. A large number 3 dinner bell sat upon a tall pole out in the creek bottom. The bell was used to call the field hands to lunch and announce quitting time. It is said the ringing of the bell was heard in three states. This house and land later became known as the Tigner place.

Wesley and Rebecca had five children. They were: Mary Ellen (11/11/1886-11/14/1886), Addie Mae (2/25/1888-5/2-1974), John McKinney (Jake) (7/9/1890-2/1985), Edgar A. (2/23/1892-11/3/1912), and Willie E. (2/20/1894-9/20/1900). Addie married Levi Carson on September 4, 1904 in Hardin County, Tennessee. Their children were Euel Wesley (1905-1907), Noel Leonard (1908-1970), Ethel Mae (1910-1912), Herman Elvoid (1913-1999), Florene Gertrude (1926). Lee and Addie remained on the Busby land until 1916 when they purchased the W. S. Long place in the Rocky Springs Community. Jake moved to Memphis, Tennessee and married Geneva Rast. Their children were William Edgar (Ed) (1915-1998) and John McKinney (June) Jr. (1918-1997). Jake played baseball for many years. At the time of his retirement, he was the oldest active baseball player. Although he never made the major league, he was inducted into the Memphis Sports Hall of Fame in the 1960's.

On March 2, 1891 Wesley and 11 others signed a petition requesting that a new 1 1/2 mile road be built from Cook's Landing to the Iuka-White Sulphur Springs Road. This road was built making the landing more accessible to Iuka.

One day in 1894 Wesley discovered a knot on his neck. The knot started to grow. He

traveled to Iuka the first week of October 1894. Dr. F. T. Carmack and J. F. Alexander did surgery to remove a cancerous tumor. The cancer continued to spread but Wesley continued to oversee his 720 acre farm. Wesley died from cancer on July 17, 1895. He was buried in the Busby family cemetery (Short Creek). His broken hearted daughter Addie placed her China head doll that her dad had brought from St. Louis on the grave. Addie visited the grave many times in the coming years. On a trip to

Hiding behind trees the boys waited for the explosion. There was a loud boom and a scream by eleven year old Wesley as his right leg was blown off below the knee. Newb carried his bleeding brother home where a hot iron was used to sear the flesh and close the dangling, torn blood vessels. With much loving care from his family, Wesley survived but his life would be changed forever. He was handicapped by having to wear a wooden leg the rest of his life. His last wooden leg is well preserved today.

After the death of his father, Wesley helped provide for his mother and younger siblings. He took over managing the operation of the family farm and opened a general merchandise store. The store had a side shed for boatmen to sleep in when the boats would dock at Cook's landing. A picture of the store exists today. Wesley loaned people money to buy land and pay taxes. By 1890 Wesley and his brothers, Newb, Wince, and Joe had accumulated many farm related machines. They were assessed additional personal property taxes for this machinery.

Wesley traveled to St. Louis by boat many times to purchase farming supplies and goods for his store. On one of these trips his younger brother Reuben Winston Price Busby went along. Wince met a beautiful young girl named Laura Ann Bartlett on this trip. Laura Ann was from Twappity (Mississippi Co.) Missouri. On another trip in 1877, 22 year old Wince and 13 year old Laura Ann were married. They lived in St. James, Missouri until about 1881.

The couple returned to the Busby land on Indian Creek and built a large two story house on the east side of the creek. Here the couple reared seven children. The eldest son Thomas Jefferson (Jeff) would become U. S. Representative from Mississippi in 1922.

In 1885 34 year old Wesley married 19 year old Ellen Rebecca Dexter. She was the

the cemetery more than fifty years later, Addie and her daughter Florene (Sis) visited Wesley's grave. To Addie's surprise, when she looked down on the grave there was the head of the doll staring back at her. This doll head is still in like-new condition today.

Rebecca now a widow with four young children married Wesley's nephew Edward Monroe Tigner on November 8, 1898. Ed was the son of Edward W. and Mary Adeline Busby Tigner. Five children would be born to this union.

Rebecca gave the land for Short Creek School on November 15, 1895. After the closing of the school, the land and the Camp Hollow would remain in the Busby family until Addie and Jake sold it to developers in 1965.

Wesley provided for the needs of his mother until his death and made arrangements for his mother to be taken care of until her death. His mother died in the spring of 1901 and Wesley's widow received 6/9 of her estate. Sarah is buried beside her husband Robert in the Busby family cemetery.

In 1984 I was informed that my wife Ann was with child. I said if it is a boy he will be named Wesley to honor the legacy of my great-grandfather Wesley Busby. As fate would have it, the child was a boy with red hair.

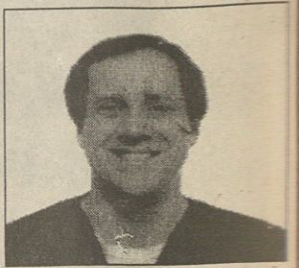

Dairy Department

A nice, cold glass of milk. Strictly kid stuff, you're thinking. Certainly not a drink for which you're over 60-something, right?

Wrong. Recent data suggests that a high-calcium intake not only helps preserve density in the leg, wrist, and other strategic bones, but also in the teeth as jaws, according to Elizabeth Krall, PhD, professor of epidemiology at the Department of Health Policy and Health Services Research at the Boston University Goldman School of Dental Medicine.

But that's not all. The protein and phosphorus content of dairy products is now thought to inhibit the formation of cavities, adds Dr. Krall. Now maybe you're wondering...at your age with a likely mouthful of fillings aren't you already booked solid when it comes to cavities? Also, there's always room for more, especially the root carries variety that is likely to develop in areas with gum recession (another age-related dental reality).

So drink that glass of milk. The best source of calcium is food, says Dr. Krall - most notably dairy products and fortified fruit juice and cereals. But since a cup of skim milk, an ounce and a half of cheddar or Swiss cheese, a serving of sardines, or a cup of yogurt delivers only 300 milligrams of calcium, you'll probably need to boost your calcium intake to meet the minimum daily requirement for your age:

- 1,200 mg for men and women over 50
- 1,500 mg for postmenopausal women not taking hormone replacements
- 1,000 mg for postmenopausal women taking hormone replacements

You can make up the difference with calcium supplements - even though they're not absorbed as effectively as food. Just make sure they contain or are accompanied by vitamin D, which aids in absorption. Liquid calcium is preferable to pills - doesn't have to be broken down by the stomach and intestines, notes Dr. Krall. You can buy it in bottles, in your choice of pineapple, orange, or other flavors. Or try softgels. They're easier to swallow than typical gigantic, chalky calcium tablets which may not completely dissolve in the stomach.

If Infant "Squints"

Parents are frequently concerned that their young children are "squinting" or looking with eyes set obliquely or crossed. It is the last meaning to which they most often refer, crossed-eyes (medically known as strabismus).

In a new baby, focusing ability is limited - if present at all - and the eyes tend to swivel around all over the place. This is why a tiny baby will sometimes produce the most disturbing squint. However, as long as this is a temporary thing, it is no cause for concern. As the baby develops, he or she will gradually learn to move both eyes in harmony.

On the other hand, if it is consistent or persists past the age of six months or so, an optometric assessment would be advisable. The condition itself can be treated either by the use of special glasses or exercises or, in some cases, by surgery to correct the controlling muscles.

Higdon's Mission Thrift Ministry

"There is a ministry in giving!" says Mrs. Zelma Higdon. She proves this with her work every day. She greets each customer with a smile, a kind word and maybe a song if she feels like it. She helps those in need and takes donations of items from clothes to books and other household things. She helps everyone, especially those in dire need with her Christian generosity and compassion.

Mrs. Higdon operates the Missionary Thrift Store in Iuka. Her's is a unique mission. She serves God by helping people both locally and around the world.

Her life was not always filled with God as the focus. She says that it was not until she was 23 years old that she and her husband were asked to attend a revival meeting that she even went to church regularly. "I was asked to go to the service and I said 'I don't want to go to church tonight', then I asked my husband. He had the same response," she says smiling.

They attended every night thereafter and the next Sunday both were baptized and accepted the Lord. For Zelma Higdon, a new life had literally begun!

One of Mrs. Higdon's sons, Dwight became "acquainted" with the Lord (as she puts it) when he was 18. At 20 years old, the Lord was calling him to preach. The young man would not surrender to the ministry. He fought it. Though he needed to preach, he had a wife and family now and thought he couldn't afford to change jobs.

With his mothers help, they prayed that God would show him the way. Mrs. Zelma says, "Through prayer all things are possible!" Through prayer, God showed them the way!

"I was sitting on my front porch one day when a U-Haul truck pulled up into my yard," Mrs. Higdon recalls. Dwight and his family got out. With tears in his eyes he said, "Momma, I got to preach the word, I packed up all I had and came on home to start." The next day they began a yard sale. The proceeds were used to start the Higdon ministry.

He preached regionally until accepting a call to minister as a missionary to the Philippines. As he made his local rounds preaching between mission trips to the Philippines, people would donate clothes and other items to take back with them.

The Filipino people are generally small in stature and most of the donated clothes would not fit. Dwight again

came to his mother with an idea. he asked her to help him open and run a Missionary thrift store.

Before this, Mrs. Higdon had seen a need to help people here in Iuka. "I love the Lord with all my heart!" says Mrs. Higdon, "and I saw people hurting and asked the Lord to use me, I had to do something to help."

Dwight found a building to rent for the thrift store and they began. Mrs. Higdon was 62 years old when she started the Missionary Thrift Store. That has been 18 years and a "whole lot of good memories" since she began serving the Lord in this way.

She uses volunteers who just want to help others who want to pay back what they have been given in time of need by Mrs. Higdon. "I can always use a little help and God sends me helpers!" Mrs. Higdon says thankfully.

The store carries clothes, books, appliances, and lots of things. It is a labor of love for this eighty-year "young" woman who may have a funny story, a smile and a song for everyone who comes into the thrift store. Stop in to speak to Mrs. Zelma Higdon and I promise that the topic will be on the Lord and your salvation before you leave.

Her motto is "You can't out give God!" If you need help, she is there. If you need a friend, Mrs. Higdon is there. And when God comes to carry his faithful servants home to heaven, I know Zelma Ruth Higdon will be there!

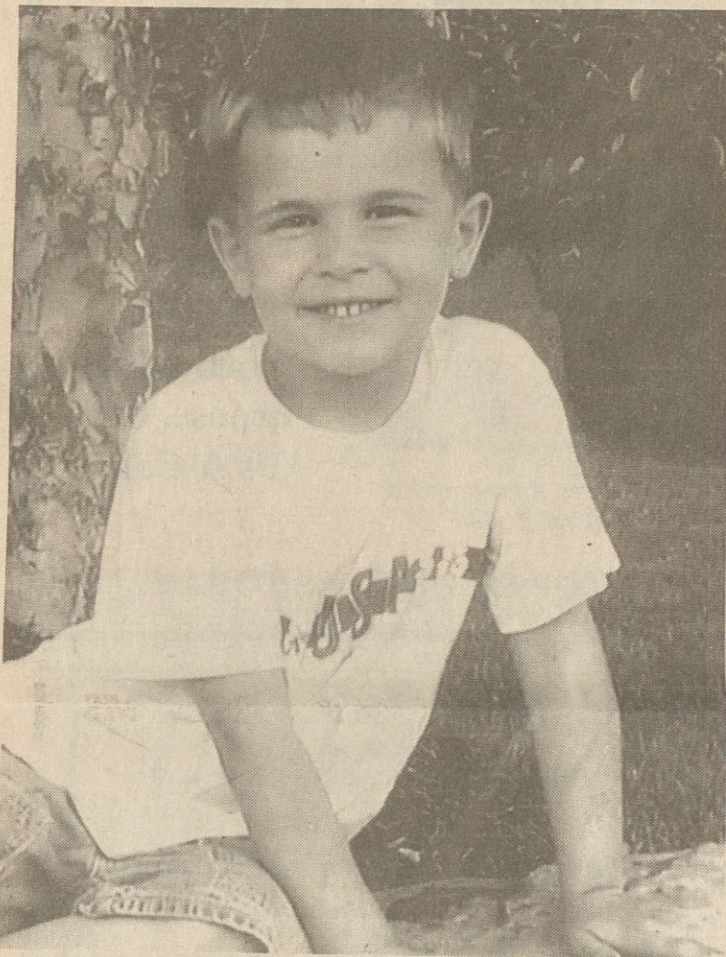

UNA Awards Phi Theta Kappa Scholarship To Emily A. Smith...

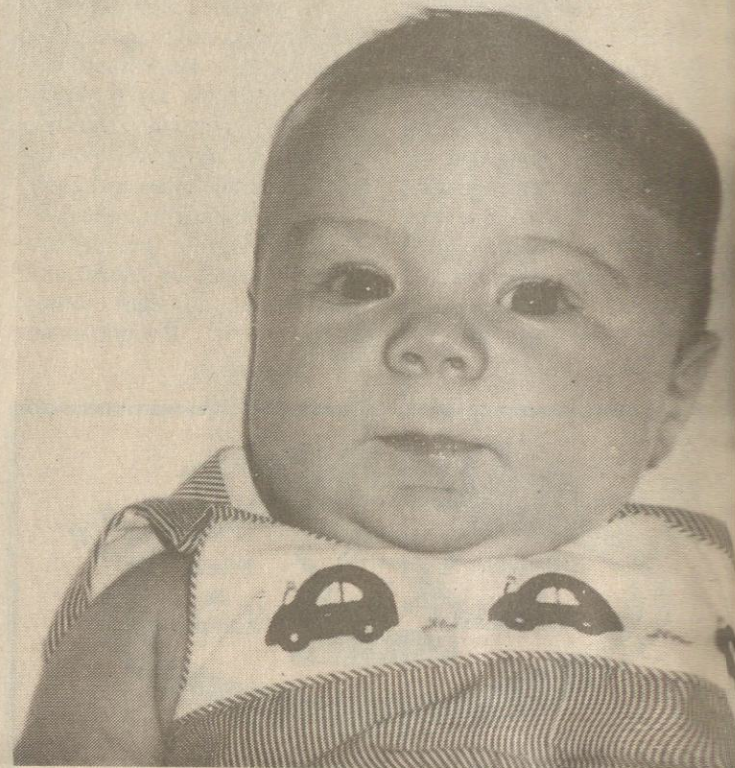
The University of North Alabama has awarded Emily A. Smith, of Iuka, a Phi Theta Kappa scholarship.

She is the daughter of Jimmy and Corinne Smith and will major in nursing in the nationally accredited College of Nursing.

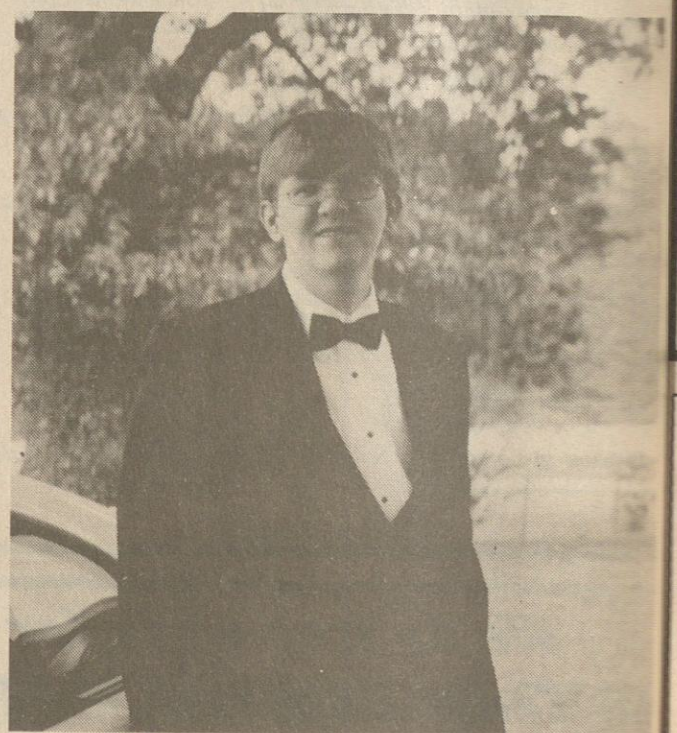

NMMC-Iuka's Cardiac Rehabilitation Program Brings Valuable Service Back Home

Iuka, Miss.-North Mississippi Medical Center-Iuka is bringing much-needed services back home. Only five months ago, NMMC-Iuka opened its Cardiac Rehabilitation Program to local patients. This program is another important service the facility is striving to bring back to the patients in our community.

NMMC-Iuka's Cardiac Rehab Program consists of three sessions a week for 12 weeks. Equipment such as treadmills, bicycles, and arm ergometers are utilized within each exercise session. Heart rate, heart rhythm, blood pressure, and perceived exertion are monitored throughout the exercise routine and reported to the participant's physician periodically.

The program is staffed by a registered nurse and a physical therapist who are both certified in Advance Cardiac Life Support and dysrhythmia interpretation. The staff caters the exercise programming to fit each individual. Requirements for the program include a history of heart disease and a physician's referral.

Coronary Artery Disease (CAD) is the blockage of damage of blood vessels caused by high cholesterol and/or high blood pressure. CAD may be worsened by diabetes, stress, or smoking. Possible effects include heart attack or even death. The American Heart Association reports that cardiovascular diseases are responsible for more than 40 percent of deaths each year.

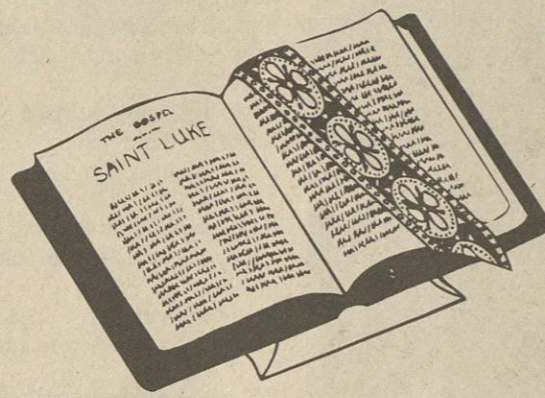



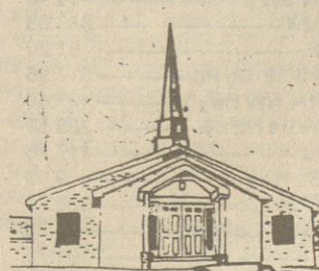

Will The Real Jesus Please Stand Up!

I have heard much talk about the meek and mild character of Jesus. Sometimes I think certain people really believe that Jesus will never judge anyone, just because He is meek and mild. I need to say that Jesus is meek and mild, but HE also has another attribute that we call the justice of God. You see, Jesus could not be the Savior of men, without doing something about the wrong that is in the world. I doubt that some people ever stop to think that if all the world were wicked, we could not continue to exist as a race of men. Wickedness is like a plague that affects all it touches. Oh, I know some people keep parroting the little idea that everybody has to do what is right for him, but when the rapist thinks it is right to molest the daughter of such thinker, their thinking will change!

Sin seems pretty tame, until the sins of others affect our lives, then it becomes some kind of monster that the government should capture and cage! Believe it or not, God has always had the best plan; it is just that men cannot seem to bring themselves to accept His plan, at least in some cases. I ask the question: Will the real Jesus please stand up? I will give the answer from Scripture that says clearly that He will stand up at the appointed time! I love the fact that God has His Own timetable; He does not depend on ours. One good man said, "God hardly ever checks with me about anything." I love

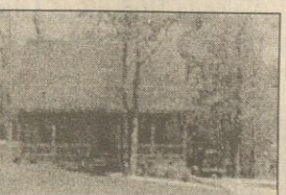

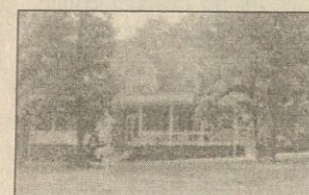

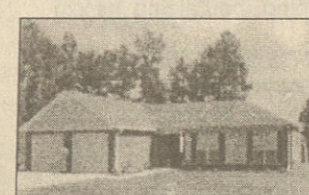
