The main objective of the program, pesented by DARE Officer Scotty Hughes, is to teach children what to do if they see The gun safety a gun. procedures taught by Eddie Eagle's Motto include: Stop! Don't Touch! Leave the Area! and Tell an Adult! This message is covered by a video, posters, "The Attic Secret" story coloring book; handouts, and a fun shuffle dance. Gun safety in relation to Peer-Pressure Television, Toy Guns vs. Real Guns, and 911 are also taught. The higher grades have skits, additional stories, and a short essay. Some of the other Safety Lessons taught are-Look both ways before crossing the street, stop, drop and roll, and never get into a vehicle with a stranger. Each child will receive a Certificate of Merit, an Eddie Eagle Motto Sticker, and the Parents' Guide to Gun Safety.

Over 19 million children have been taught the Eddie Eagle Gun Safety Program since 1988. There are approximately 80 million gun owners and an estimated 200 million guns under private ownership in the United Fatal firearm States. accidents among children have been reduced more than

Double Vision

In a child whose eyes are normally aligned, both eyes focus on an object at the same time. When the brain receives the image, it is the result of what is seen by both eyes fused into a single image. This is known as binocular single vision.

However, when one eye is out of line, the child will see two objects. One image will show the object in its proper position. The misaligned eye will show the object displaced or off center, a phenomenon known as double vision. A child who experiences double vision will compensate for it by ignoring the image received by the misaligned eye. He suppresses the disturbing second image. The misaligned eye then becomes a "lazy eye", referred to medically as amblyopia.

Sometimes the misaligned eye can be straightened by wearing corrective glasses alone or in combination with drops and exercises. The success of any treatment depends on how soon it be-
