Effects Of Divorce On Children And Marriages

The increase in divorce has elicited more concern than any other family-related trend in the U.S. Citing the numbers below in Mississippi; there are vulnerable children involved in these divorces at a critical stage in their development. According to the Mississippi Department of Health (MSDH) in 2000, there were:

- 19,879 marriages in Mississippi and 14,177 divorces.
- Of those divorces, 3,505 involved one minor child, 2,492 involved two children, and 824 involved three

or more children.

- The highest numbers of divorced couples were married five to nine years and the second highest numbers were married ten to nineteen years.

According to a report in U.S. News and World Report (1993), children growing up in single parent families are:

- six times as likely as children from two-parent families to be poor;
- two to three times more likely to have emotional and behavioral problems;
- more likely to drop out of school and be expelled or suspended;
- more prone to be suicidal;
- more likely to suffer child abuse;
- more likely to use drugs and get into trouble with the law; and
- more likely to get pregnant as teenagers.

Pat Fagan, researcher with the Heritage Foundation, says the "absence of marriage is the major factor in explaining crime rates and poverty." He reported in 2002 that out-of-wedlock births increased from 7 percent of all births in the mid 1960's to 33 percent today. Children do better when their own "married" parents rear them.

While these statistics indicate negative consequences for children of broken homes, the Healthy Marriage Initiative is not suggesting that all

children from broken homes have these problems. There are many two-parent families with children who have the problems listed above.

For clarification purposes in our articles, although we advocate healthy marriages, we do not encourage anyone to stay in an abusive relationship or marriage. We partner with SAFE, Inc., a domestic violence shelter that is available to provide services and assist anyone with such concerns. However, we do not work for SAFE and have no knowledge of the clients who contact them. The Healthy Marriage programs we offer are primarily in high school classes for high school students.

Double Vision

In a child whose eyes are normally aligned, both eyes focus on an object at the same time. When the brain receives the image, it is the result of what is seen by both eyes fused into a single image. This is known as binocular single vision.

However, when one eye is out of line, the child will see two objects. One image will show the object in its proper position. The misaligned eye will show the object displaced or off center, a phenomenon known as double vision. A child who experiences double vision will compensate for it by ignoring the image received by the misaligned eye. He suppresses the disturbing second image. The misaligned eye then becomes a "lazy eye", referred to medically as amblyopia.

Sometimes the misaligned eye can be straightened by wearing corrective glasses alone or in combination with drops and exercises. The success of any treatment depends on how soon it begins.

This has been such an amazing year, our 4th grade class has had exciting volunteers.

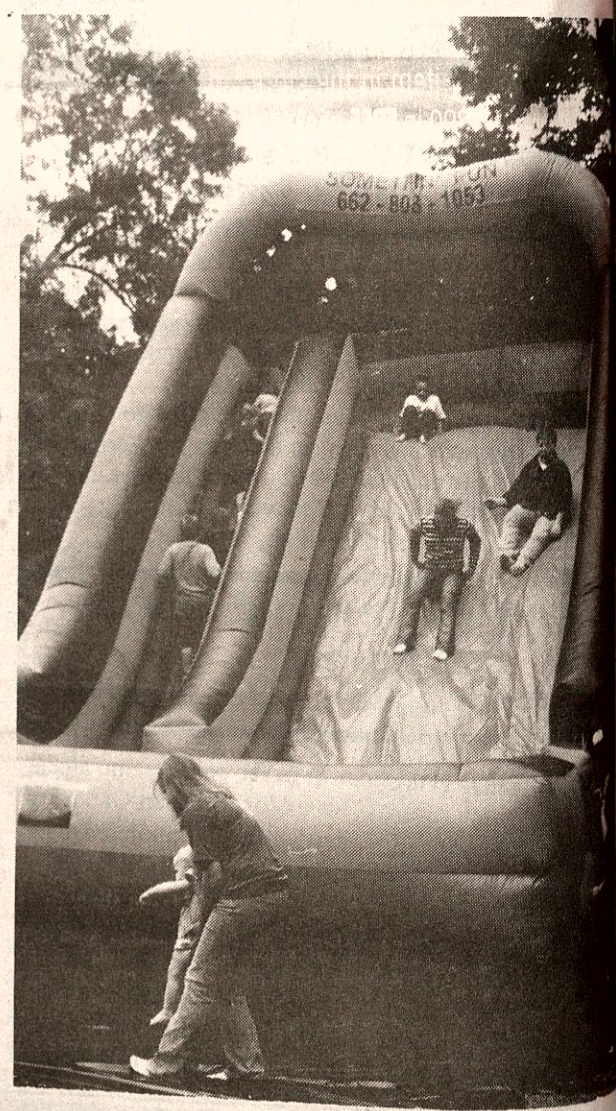

Students at the Iuka Baptist Daycare are the first to enjoy some of the new books that just arrived at the Iuka Public Library. Thanks to the Friends of the Iuka Library and the Libri Foundation young readers in Iuka will have plenty of books to captivate their minds this summer. The books were made possible by a grant from the Libri Foundation, a national organization that provides new, quality books to small rural libraries through local matching funds.

The Friends provided \$350 of the total \$1050 worth of new books. Librarian Fredda Anderson said, "It is our belief that the more resources we offer the children in our community, the more the library is used and the better informed children in our community will become. Our goal is to have books that will 'flip the switch' and make our children lifelong readers." Children attending the Iuka Baptist Daycare come to the library for story time.

New Immunizations Required For 2007-2008 School Year

The Mississippi Department of Health (MDH) announces two new requirements for childhood immunizations effective for the 2007-2008 school year. These requirements are recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices and must be met in order for a child to enroll in any childcare facility or school within the state.

Effective August 1, 2007, the Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCV7) or "Prevnar," has been added as a requirement for children under five years old entering childcare for the first time. Parents of children al-

ready in childcare should also start making plans to make sure their children have been vaccinated with this pneumonia vaccine. Beginning January 2008, all children, including those already enrolled in childcare, will be required to be vaccinated with the recommended doses of the pneumococcal vaccine. Research has shown the vaccine virtually eliminates invasive pneumococcal disease (including meningitis) in infants and young children, according to

Joy Sennett, Director of Communicable Diseases for MDH. Additionally, effective August 1, 2007, children entering school for the first time

will be required to have two doses of the Varicella vaccine (chickenpox vaccine) or a history of chickenpox. Research shows the success rate of 80 to 85 percent with one dose increases to more than 90 percent efficiency with two doses. One dose of Varicella vaccine or a history of chickenpox became a requirement for entry into childcare and

five-year-old kindergarten in 2002.

Both vaccines are available at all county health departments and from Vaccines for Children providers for a \$10 administrative fee each.

MDH's Immunization Registry program records immunizations received by individuals from public clinics and participating private doctors. Records for many adults and most children are available for parents and qualified professionals.
