Alcorn County Wreck Claims Life Of Former Iuka Resident

A former Iuka resident was killed Sunday afternoon, June 10, 2007, in the Kossuth area of Alcorn County as the result of a one-vehicle wreck.

Glenda Lynn Jones, 24, formerly of Iuka—most recently of Red Bay, Ala.—lost her life as a passenger in the crash which occurred on Alcorn County Road 520 around 5:30 Sunday.

Two Alcorn County residents—Phillip Hutcheson, the

driver of the 2000 Chevrolet Silverado pickup truck involved, and Megan Smith, another passenger—were both transported to the Med in Memphis, Tenn. and were in critical condition at press time.

Another passenger, Avery Dodds of Corinth, was transported to Magnolia Regional Hospital for observation and was released.

According to reports, Hutcheson was apparently driving westbound on Alcorn County Road 520, about a half mile from Hwy 2 in the Kossuth area when the vehicle went off the left side of the road as the vehicle was rounding a turn. The vehicle apparently flipped over at least three times during which Jones was thrown out. She was pronounced dead at the scene.

Memphis Truck Driver Dies After Medical Emergency Occurs In Burnsville

A Memphis man traveling through Burnsville Wednesday afternoon, June 6, in his 18-wheeler, suffered a medical emergency at the scene where the back tires of his truck had caught fire.

According to Burnsville Police Chief Mike Shipman, an 18-wheeler tractor trailer, headed west on Hwy 72 in Burnsville, was spotted with heavy smoke coming from the rear trailer tires. Shortly afterwards, the truck pulled into the Burnsville Amoco Service Station where Emergency Responders and Burnsville

Police responded.

Upon arrival, they found the driver, James Beane, 66, of Memphis, lying on the ground near the back tires which had caught fire. According to Chief Shipman, Beane was gasping for breath.

After being checked over by the EMR's from Burnsville and also from Iuka, he was given oxygen until he gained consciousness, Shipman said. The driver refused to be taken to the hospital at that time.

Chief Shipman reported that the man appeared to have two more attacks after that,

while sitting in his truck and was eventually transported to the Iuka Hospital.

Tishomingo County Coroner Mack Wilemon stated that the truck driver, Beane, had been in the hospital for a few hours when he got a call that the driver had passed away. Wilemon said the cause of death was of natural causes and occurred at approximately 1:00 a.m. Thursday.

Beane was a driver for MLG Trucking of Memphis, Tenn.

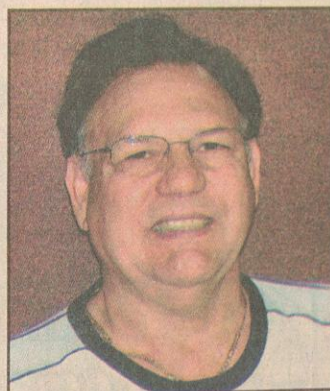

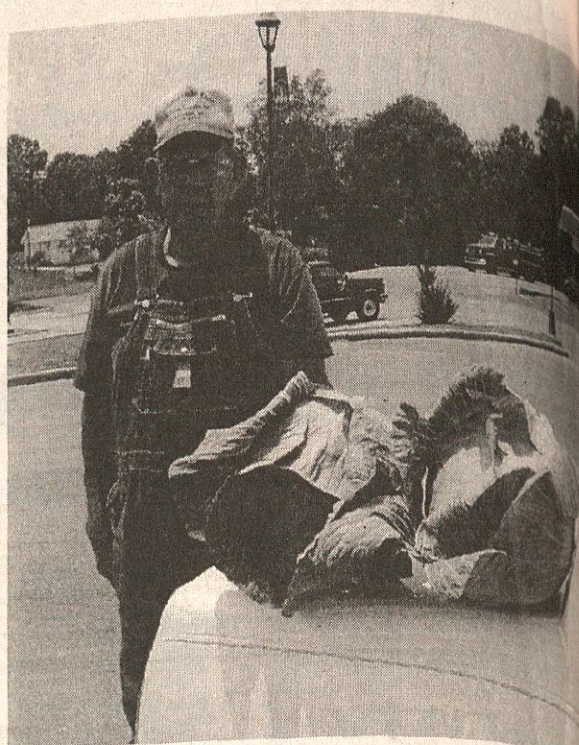

Uncoordinated Eye Movement

If you've noticed your son or daughter's eye movement don't seem to be as coordinated as it should be, this may be caused by an eye condition known as strabismus. The most common form of this condition is crossed eyes in which the eyes deviate inward. In other forms of strabismus they can also deviate upward or outward. In any of these forms of strabismus the deviation may be constant or it may happen occasionally. Whatever the form, strabismus is a serious condition that should be treated as soon as possible. Both eyes can learn to see properly at the same time. In child's first year of life, the eyes may move somewhat because of insufficiently developed muscle coordination. This is usually temporary and the eyes straighten out normally. If uncoordinated eye movement is still evident before the child reaches the age of 3, it is probably strabismus problem.

"Special damages" are those awarded for such compensable harms as medical expenses and lost wages. These can easily be quantified with the help of bills, pay stubs, etc.

Tishomingo Co. Tax Assessor's Office Begins Modernizing Tax Maps

The Tishomingo County Tax Assessor's Office has begun the process of modernizing the County's tax maps. Using aerial photography obtained from the state and additional aerial photography paid for by the County, the paper tax maps are being digitized for use in a computer system called a Geographic Information System (GIS). The end result is a single computer map of the entire county that is connected to the digital tax roll. The County Assessor, Ms. Diana Turner, will allow public use of the GIS at her office, or through a website that is being developed under this project.

This system allows for a person to sit at a computer and be able to easily locate any property in the County by owner name, address, or Parcel Identification Number (PIN), and print their area of interest. Owners of adjacent properties can be found by simply "clicking" on the property and the information will display on the computer screen. This will significantly help the developers and other potential property buyers in purchasing property in Tishomingo County, and will be an invaluable tool in attracting new business to the County.

This system is being developed by Geographic Computer Technologies, LLC out of Gulfport, MS. Turner expects the system to be fully operational by the spring of 2008. www.geoportalmaps.com/ms/tishomingo.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF IUKA, MISSISSIPPI PROHIBITING DISPOSAL OF WASTE WITHOUT PERMIT BY PERSONS OR ENTITIES INTO MUNICIPAL SEWAGE LAGOONS AND PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES THEREFOR

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Iuka, Mississippi, deem it necessary and advisable in promoting the health, safety and general welfare of its citizens and inhabitants and the environs of the City to enact an Ordinance prohibiting the disposal of waste without permit by persons and entities into the municipal sewage lagoons, and providing the enforcement thereof with penalties for the violation of the same;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the City of Iuka, Mississippi, that:

It shall be unlawful for any person or entity, without a written permit issued hereafter by the Clerk of the City through the Water and Sewer Department, to dump or dispose of any waste material into the sewage lagoons of the City of Iuka, Mississippi. Such permit may be issued only upon written application to the Mayor and Board of Aldermen and a sufficient showing that the proposed dumping or disposal of waste material would not pollute, damage or harm the lagoons and waste water system to the extent that their operation and efficiency would be adversely affected. The granting of any permit shall be conditioned upon the payment of a fee and such other conditions as the Board may require. Any permit shall not be transferable and shall be valid for a period of not more than one year, but may be renewed upon proper application at the Board's discretion. Any permit made be revoked upon fifteen days written notice to the holder of a hearing and a finding by the Board that continued use under the permit constitutes a hazard to the health, safety and welfare of the community or the public.

Any person violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be fined not more than \$1,000.00 and incarcerated for not more than 30 days, or be subjected to both such fine and incarceration. In addition, if any person or entity shall violate the conditions of any permit issued hereunder, such person or entity shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be subjected to the above penalties, and such permit shall be revoked.

This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after its passage. The Clerk of the City is hereby directed to publish this Ordinance one time in the *Tishomingo County News*.

The above and foregoing Ordinance was adopted by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen at a regular meeting held on the 5th day of May, 2007.

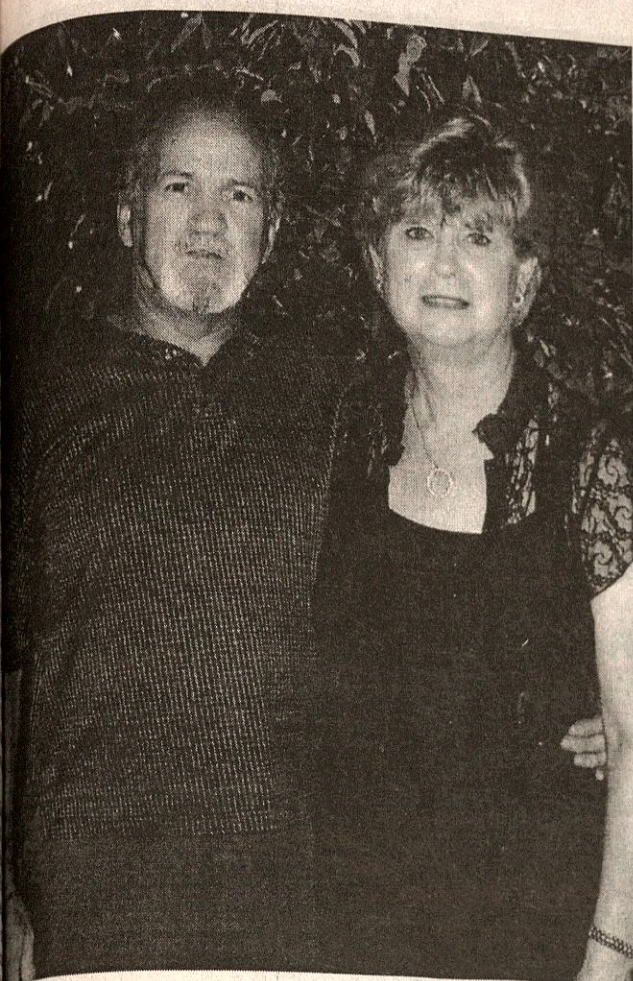

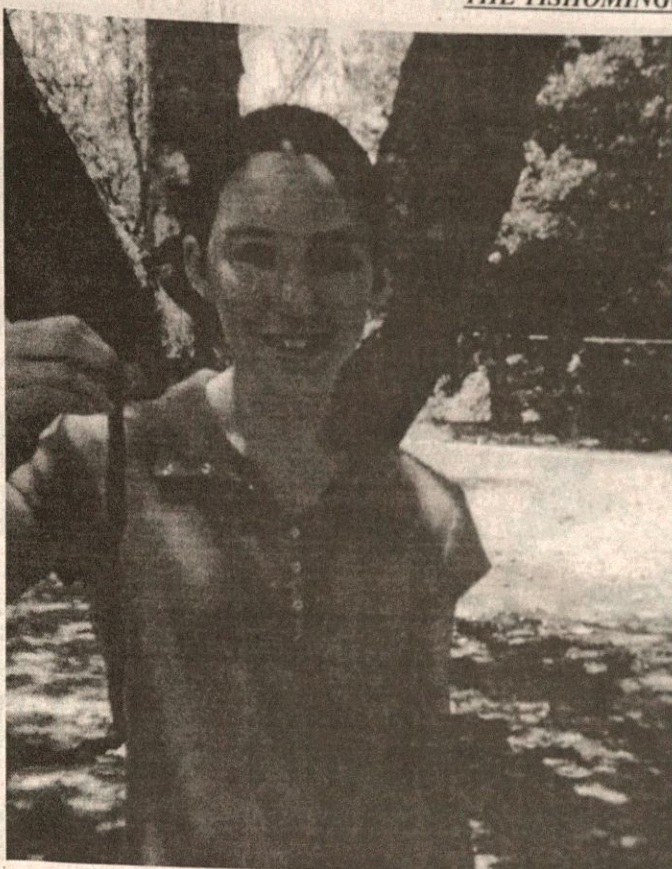

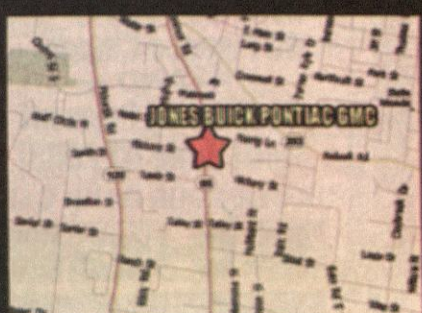
