uka ABE Program Offers hances for Self-Improvement vith GED, ACT, Job Training

More than 30 people essfully completed the D program last year, and director of Iuka's ABE gram is expecting at least next few months.

Lisa Hatfield has been rating the Northeast Misippi Community College a Adult Basic Education BE) Program from the ce on Bettydale Drive the last two years, and is ited about the recent sucses - because that means t lives are changed. Her itement is obvious as she sents a list of recent sucses, many of whom helped ebrate Christmas at their

en House last week. One local example of man whose life has been anged is Cody Tidwell.

"I had quit high school, HI was working for a guy ving a tractor," Cody said. finally said to myself, 'I'm ng nowhere,' and started king into doing someng about it."

He went to see Mrs. at the ABE office and told him about a popular gram that actually pays 00 to those who complete GED, and even pays mile-

age to get to the classes, and child care expenses, if necessary. He took the practice tests, and with Hatfield's encouragement, set a goal to get his GED. About a month many to complete it in after making his initial decision, he has a GED in hand and has plans to join the local National Guard and study aviation. He hopes to learn to

fly helicopters. "Mrs. Lisa made everything so easy for me," Tidwell recounted in an interview Monday. "Without her, I don't know if I would have done it, but I feel really good about it all now... setting a goal and achieving it."

"Last year, we had about 30 who passed the GED," reports Hatfield. "In the next couple months, I expect that many again to finish. The incentive program that paid Tidwell has been popular with others, too. It is funded by a Workforce Investment Act grant through the WIN Job Center, and Ginger Jones, of Northeast Mississippi Community College is

administering the program. The GED, or General Equivalency Diploma, is required for most jobs, in the absence of a high school diploma, and even to join the

electrical union or contractors' unions, Hatfield said. It has five parts - science, social studies, reading, math and writing, and it allows those who pass it to attend college, as well as opening the numerous doors that are just no longer open to high school dropouts.

The ABE program also offers skills training to help its clients become more employable. Hatfield said. she helps students learn to improve their ACT scores, offers basic computer training, and helps them improve their chances of becoming employed by improving their resumes and learning some

networking. They have had a lot of interest lately from those who have been laid off. Hatfield said she is helping some work toward obtaining their EMT or CNA certification, as they take advantage of the opportunity to make career changes.

The program operates out of an office at 1208 Bettydale Drive, near the WIC office and health depart-

The History of Santa Claus

Santa Claus has been called by several different names throughout the years. Traditions and legends of Santa Claus for the evolution of the modernday Santa may been based on the early Dutch legend of Sinter Klaas, originating in the 1600's.

Santa Claus really started to get famous when American author Washington Irving published stories about Santa Claus, referring to him as Saint Nicholas who arrived on Christmas Eve bringing presents for children.


