## Tishomingo Receives Spirit Award this Week for Centennial Tree Project

The Town of Tishomingo will be receiving the 2009 City Spirit Award for its Centennial Tree Project at the Mississippi Municipal League annual conference this week.

Begun by the Tishomingo Chamber of Commerce and the town of Tishomingo in 2006 in anticipation of the Town's centennial anniversary last year, the project has surpassed their goal of "100 trees for the next 100 years."

"We began the program as a result of the loss of numerous old trees in the public areas of town due to ice storm injury and disease or storm damage," said Anne Taylor, President of

the Chamber of Commerce at the time the program began. "We have been thrilled with the response of the people who love Tishomingo. They have donated trees or money to plant 168 trees at the current time. This was a centennial year project, but we plan to continue, as other trees will no doubt be lost over time."

The Mississippi Municipalities League has recognized the project with its 2009 City Spirit Award for Cities Under 10,000. The Mississippi Municipal League Excellence Awards program recognizes cities and towns for meeting the challenges of municipal government through innovative problem solving, ex-

cellence in management, citizen participation and striving to provide a higher level of service. Each year, awards are given in the areas of public safety, planning and economic development and city spirit. Winners are recognized at the MML Annual Conference in Biloxi in July.

While the Chamber of Commerce has handled publicity, finances and details for the project, the town employees have planted the majority of the trees. The Master Gardeners of Tishomingo County assisted in one large planting.

In addition, Mr. Cleston Barnes, a part time summer employee of the town, watered the first trees to get them through that year's summer drought. Funds donated above the initial cost of trees are used to replace any trees that die. Hopefully everyone will be aware of these trees and help protect and nurture them. In addition to beautifying the town, science proves that trees improve air quality and help control rain-water runoff, benefits for all citizens.

Each tree is a living memorial to someone who cared for Tishomingo. Plaques in City Hall list the names of those honored. There is a print copy of the registry at City Hall as well. In addition, the complete registry is available at the Town web site, [www.tishomingo.ms](http://www.tishomingo.ms), under "Our Community" with the names of those who donated, the location of that particular tree, and the variety.

"Beyond improving the town for all of us here today, I see these trees as a link between the past and the future," said Ms. Taylor. "Hopefully, they will be here long after I am not, to remind our children and grandchildren that this was our home."

## School Board Approves New Teachers for 2009-2010

At the regular meeting of the Tishomingo County School Board Monday evening, the board approved several new positions.

At Belmont, Bradley Todd Marlar was approved to teach high school social studies and coach softball. Marlar is originally from Burnsville, but this is his first time teaching in the county system, said Superintendent Malcolm Kuykendall.

At Tishomingo County High

School, two new English teachers were approved: Sara Savoy, a TC alumna, who just finished at Mississippi State; and Cindy Howie, who taught previously at IMS, and is returning to teaching.

Jeffery Boren was approved to teach social studies and be an assistant TC football coach.

DeShaune Holiday was approved as an assistant in the autistic class at TCHS.

Shane Wigginton is coming from Alcorn County to teach science at TC.

At Iuka Middle School, Bridget Gray was approved as the new school nurse.

State Area Test Program (SATP) test results have been received by the district, but are under state "embargo" according to Superintendent Kuykendall.

The board also approved a new payment policy for substitute teachers. Non-degreed substitutes daily compensation will go from \$53 to \$58 a day. Degreed substitutes will get \$66 a day, up from \$61.

## TCEPA Accepting Nominations for Five Board Positions

In accordance with the By-laws of Tishomingo County Electric Power Association, nominations for positions on the Board of Directors are now being accepted. There will be five positions open for election. One director is to be elected for a three (3) year term for each of the following supervisors' districts: 1st, 2nd, 4th, 5th, and an area at-large position.

Members of the Association may make nominations by either of the following methods:

1. By petition bearing the signature of at least fifteen (15) members: Petitions must be received by the Secretary of the Board of Directors at least seven (7) days prior to the day of the Annual Meeting. Petitions may be presented for qualification at the Main Office of the Association during regular business hours, Monday thru Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

2. From the floor of the Annual Meeting to be held August 8, 2009: The By-laws require that five (5) percent of the membership be physically present in order that nominations may be made from the floor.

Nominees must be residents of the supervisors' districts which they will represent. Any member, regardless of place of residence, may be nominated for the area at large position, provided, that the nominees for the at large position may not be residents of the fourth supervisors' district. This district presently has a resident serving in an at-large position.

### NOTICE OF TAX INCREASE TISHOMINGO COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT

The Tishomingo County Special Municipal Separate School District will hold a public hearing on its proposed school district budget for fiscal year 2009-2010 on July 27, 2009, 5:00 p.m., at the Superintendent's office. At this meeting, a proposed ad valorem tax effort increase shall be considered.

The Tishomingo County Special Municipal Separate School District is now operating with projected total budget revenue of \$27,530,863. 15% or \$4,241,545, of such revenue is obtained through ad valorem taxes. For the next fiscal year, the proposed budget has total projected revenue of \$28,270,054. Of that amount 16% or \$4,511,219, is proposed to be financed through a total ad valorem tax levy.

For the next fiscal year, the Tishomingo County Special Municipal Separate School District plans to increase your ad valorem tax millage rate by two mills from 36 mills to 38 mills.

This increase in ad valorem tax revenue means that you will pay more in ad valorem taxes on your home, automobile tag, utilities, business fixtures and equipment and rental real property.

Any citizen of Tishomingo County Special Municipal Separate School District is invited to attend this public hearing, and will be allowed to speak for a reasonable amount of time and offer tangible evidence before any vote is taken.

## HCAHPS Tool Helps Consumers Choose

When consumers are looking to make a big purchase - a new washing machine, a car, a television or a multitude of other items, one of the first things some do is start researching online.

On the Internet, consumers can read about the product, compare it to other similar products and read reviews from others who have bought the same thing before shelling out the cash to make a purchase.

"When people are in need of health care, we want them to know they can do the same type of research on hospitals and providers online," said Fred Truesdale, administrator of North Mississippi Medical Center-Iuka.

In the summer of 2002, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) asked the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality to develop an instrument to measure patient perceptions of care. From that, HCAHPS was developed.

HCAHPS stands for Hospital Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems. This measurement is used to publicly report hospital performance, to provide consumers with information that might be helpful in choosing a hospital.

An HCAHPS survey is organized under the following headings: Your Care from Nurses, Your Care from Doctors, Your Experiences in the Hospital,

When You Left the Hospital, Overall Rating of the Hospital and About You. Press Ganey surveys can be sent to any patient who has

used the services at NMMC-Iuka or any other hospital.

The information measures how well hospitals care for their patients. Hospitals volunteer to be a part of this grading system, and it is a tool CMS uses to help determine payment to the hospital.

According to the Web site, hospitals can use this information to do the following:

- Talk to health care providers and hospital staff about what this information means and how it can be used to make health care decisions.

- Review the performance of hospitals in the state.

- Gather information about other hospitals.

"This Web site includes a wealth of information to help inform patients on the type of care hospitals in the area are providing," Truesdale said. "It is updated regularly and you can do a search to compare all the hospitals in our area, which should help patients make more informed health care decisions."
