## New Welcome Signs for Tishomingo

The Town of Tishomingo is again marked at both the north and south entrances by welcome signs. The new ones feature steel silhouettes of namesake Chief Tishomingo.

The steel signs were fabricated by students at Tishomingo County Technical Center, and the south one, above, was installed

just recently. The expense for the signs was shared by the Town and the Chamber, and they replace signs that were installed on fieldstone bases in the 1980s by the Chamber.

## Delinquent Land Tax Sale Monday, August 31st

Paul Whitlock, Tax Collector, issued a reminder to all property owners that the delinquent land tax sale will be August 31, 2009.

The law requires that a delinquent tax list be run in the paper two weeks before sale day. These taxes need to be paid before August 17, 2009 to prevent them from being advertised.

If you are not sure if taxes have been paid, please call the tax collector's office at 423-7048 and they will be glad to assist you.

The law now requires mobile homes that have delinquent taxes be sold to settle the tax lien. It is very important that all taxes on mobile homes be paid to prevent problems related to the delinquent tax lien.

## Rare Find: Tishomingo 5th Grader Helps State Document Unusual Plant

A Tishomingo student and his mom have found a rare plant on their family land in Prentiss County and last week the state botanist came to help identify it.

After visiting with Heather Sullivan, a botanist at the Mississippi Museum of Natural Science last Thursday, the fifth grader's hunch that he had found a special plant was proved correct.

On family land in Prentiss County, Zac Chase and his mom, Vicki Putnam, found a plant called ground cedar, or Southern running pine that has only been documented to grow in a few places in Northeast Mississippi. Vicki has known about the plant's presence on her dad's land since the early 1990s, but recently, she and Zac located it again, and he plans to try to propagate it at his home in Tishomingo as an ongoing project.

"The plant, *Diphasiastrum digitatum*, belongs to the club moss family and reproduces by spores," explained Sullivan in an

interview with Zac last week. "It's really a plant from dinosaur times. Some varieties have been found fossilized in petrified wood when they dug the Waterway."

In Mississippi, locations of ground cedar have only been previously documented in Clay, Oktibbeha, Tishomingo, and Tippah counties. The plant is more widespread in the northeastern part of the county and Southern Canada.

In the early days of photography, the flammable spores of this plant were harvested to make flash powder for cameras, Sullivan explained to Zac.

Members of the family have tried to transplant the low-growing cedar-like plant into gardens and containers around the house with no success, said Putnam. This could be because the creeping evergreen feeds on a fungus that grows from decaying hardwoods. It doesn't actually have roots, but runners that are actually above the surface.

The specimen in Tishomingo County

is near the Tishomingo State Park and it is a transplant, so Zac may have success, since the climate conditions in the county have supported its growth before, said Sullivan.

Sullivan will enter the new data on the plant into the Heritage Program, which works with the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks to look after rare and unusual plants and animals in the state. They monitor their presence in the state and make recommendations on their management to preserve them for the future, explained Sullivan.

The information is used to make sure that human development doesn't fatally threaten existing populations, she said. The Prentiss County ground cedar site is threatened by the ongoing construction of Highway 30, and that could have been slightly rerouted to avoid the plant if its location had been known. Highway 6 was rerouted to avoid such a situation, said Sullivan.

## Tishomingo Alderman Election Next Tuesday

The town of Tishomingo will hold a special election next Tuesday, August 18th to fill the term of one alderman position.

According to Town Clerk Paula Rushing, candidates on the ballot are Shirl Butler and Charles Carr. The election will fill the nearly full term of Jimmy Burns, who died shortly after being re-elected in June.

Last Friday, after consulting

extensively with the Mississippi Secretary of State's office, and the Attorney General, the Town of Tishomingo Election Commission denied eligibility for another candidate, Van Buchanan, because he was not registered to vote in the Town of Tishomingo.

Hours for voting are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Tuesday, at Tishomingo City Hall.

## Courthouse Issues Dress Code for Court

As a response to some distracting modes of dress that have been appearing in their courtroom, some judges who work in Tishomingo County have issued a dress code.

Issued by Bailiff Lamar Bolton, at the direction of the Chancery Court judges, the dress code calls for some common decency to be exercised by those appearing or attending court proceedings.

Attire should reflect respect

for the court and the serious business they are all there to conduct, said officials.

On the list of forbidden garments are untucked shirts, shorts, sagging pants, halter tops, short skirts and shirts that fail to cover mid-sections.

Furthermore, all cell phones are to be turned off in the courtroom, and no hats are to be worn.

The rules are posted on all the courtroom doors.

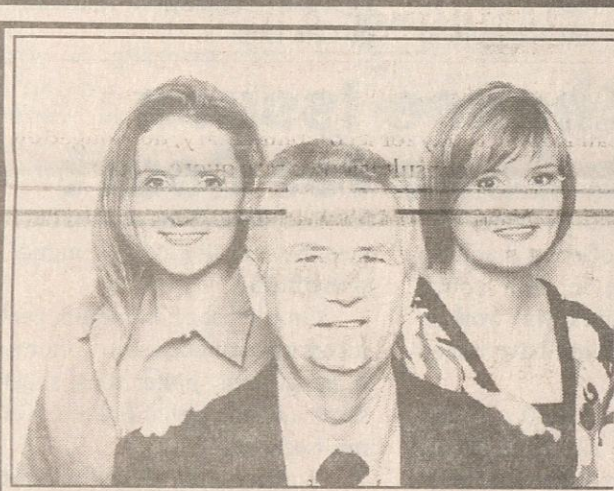

## Vision & Learning

If your child is having any problems with vision, this could be having a noticeable effect on ability to do well in school. For example, good near vision is the ability to focus and see clearly and comfortably with both eyes and each eye separately at a distance between 13 and 16 inches. This is the distance at which the child will be using his eyes for work at his or her desk.

In good distance vision, the same ability is needed as in near vision but for a distance of 10 feet or more. This is important for seeing the blackboard and visual presentation such as slides, movies, and video tapes as well as for participation in sports and other school activities. Binocular coordination, the ability to make two eyes work together for single vision accuracy and good depth perception, is also important for good vision. Chances are your child won't tell you if he or she has a vision problem. Only an eye exam will tell.
