Donna Henry Dill, Circuit Clerk, announces that absentee ballots are now available for the 1st Kryublican Pen for United States House of Representatives, 1st Congressional District. You may come to the Circuit Clerk's Office to vote by absentee Monday - Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. The clerk's office will also be open on Saturday, May 22 and 29th, 8 a.m. to 12 noon, for absentee voting,

We encourage those who need to your by mad to call our office as soon as possible so they will have ample time to go through the absenter procres. When an absentee bullet is requested, an application for an absentee ballot will first be mailed to the worre. This application shall be completed by the absentee voter and maded back to the circuit clerk's office. When the application is received, the bullot will be mailed to the voter. No absenire ballots may be hand delivered to aspone.

Any registered voter is eligible to vote by absenter in the clerk's office, but only five groups are allowed to wore absenue by mail. These five groups are:

I. A registered voter who is 65 years of age or older;

2. A registered voter who is temporarsly residing outside the

3. A regulared voter who is temporarily or permanently physically disabled, and/or 4. A registered voter who is

the parent, spouse or dependent of a temporarily or permanently physically disabled person who is hospitalized ounside the county or more than 50 miles away

from his/her residence and will he with that person on Election.

5. All woters who are me of the Armot Services, or other waters than full within the Armed Services Absence Vening Law.

All absence applications and ballot envelopes must be noterard except for a regimened voter who is physically disabled, either permanently or temporarily. The disabled voner's application and ballot emelope must be witnessed and signed by a person. 18 years of age or older. This wis-

#### Insight Into Eyesight

While most of us think of tears as symbols of sadness, they also play an important role in keeping our eyes healthy. Tears are a natural mixture of salt, water, and microbial enzymes that kill bacteria and a think layer of lubricating fluid that slows evaporation.

Dry eyes occur when the ocular surface of the eye lacks an adequate protective tear layer. This leaves the eye exposed to common irritating elements, such as dust, smoke and pollen.

Symptoms of dry eyes include burning, redness and sensations of having a foreign object in the eye. Doctors usually recommend the use of tear replacement eyedrops which contain many of the major components of natural tears.

Decreased production and abnormal tear composition are associated causes of dryeye. Aging, menopause, arthritis and infection are probable causes for either decreased tear production or abnormal tear composition.







#### **Northeast Women's Basketball Schedules Summer Camps**
