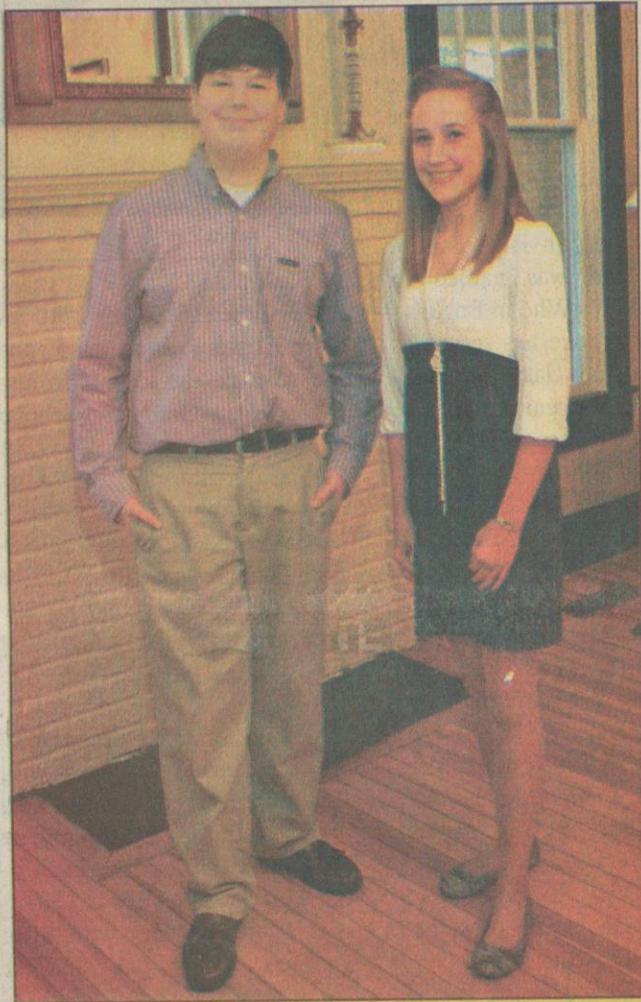

New TAP Alliance Starts Business Promoting Regional Development

Monday, Tishomingo County finalized its participation in the new TAP Alliance, when the board authorized the county's contribution of \$5,000 into a fund for the new industrial development entity.

The TAP Alliance, including Tishomingo, Alcorn and Prentiss counties, is modeled after the PUL Alliance, a cooperative agreement between Pontotoc, Union and Lee counties, which managed to successfully lure Toyota to build a plant in Blue Springs. The goal of the TAP Alliance is to assist in the future development of a regional industrial park and other projects that will provide economic benefits, including but not limited to industry, distribution, commerce, tourism, health care and other purposes in which the public purpose and interest of the people of the State of Mississippi are served.

The new board of the TAP alliance was recently elected, with Tishomingo County Supervisor Brandon Grissom in the president's position. The vice president is mayor Joe Eaton of Boonville, and David "Bubba"

Pounds, Prentiss County Chancery Clerk is secretary.

Each county board, and each county seat city in the TAP Alliance area are represented on the TAP board, including Tishomingo County Fifth District Supervisor James McDowell, and Iuka Mayor Jackie Bryant.

Each county and city said they would contribute \$5,000, which gives the Alliance \$30,000 to start marketing the area, and to help pay for the development of a regional economic strategic plan. This plan would identify strengths of the area, and possibilities for what would be the best industry for the area. One of the

main sites they are focusing on is the 900-acre North Mississippi Waterway Industrial Park in Burnsville, owned by the Yellow River Port Authority, said Grissom Monday.

"The TAP Alliance brings together a region that is better able to compete in the global economy for economic development projects," said McDowell. "Tishomingo, Alcorn and Prentiss Counties have much in common, not only in business and industry, but also historically and culturally. In essence, the partnership brings closer together the three counties that once one county."

agency, the board couldn't help him with his issues, but he was advised to talk to the secretary of state's office. They also said they would look into the fact that the county pays insurance on the county-owned facility, when the rescue squad regularly has fund raisers in the building.
