## Iuka 9-10 All Stars Headed to State Tournament After Battling for Second Place in North Half

Some Iuka boys know what it's like to work through some hard times after a hot weekend in Cleveland, Mississippi last week.

The Iuka 9-10 year-old All Star team took second place in the District Tournament in Amory the weekend of July 9-11th. That gave them a ticket to the North Half Tournament in Cleveland this past weekend.

They had a heartbreaking 8-0 loss to Kosciusko on Friday night, and heads were hanging low, reported some of the parents. That put them in the losers' bracket, where they began to rally back Saturday morning.

Saturday, they managed to beat all opponents! Beginning with a 12-1 win over Belzoni, they moved on to victory over Yazoo City (12-1), Washington County (3-3), and finally a 12-8 win over Cleveland ensured them a spot in the championship - against Kosciusko, again. Kosciusko was undefeated in tournament play.

Monday afternoon, Iuka met Kosciusko again, and beat them 3-1 in the last inning of the first game to force a true championship game, said Coach Chris Cornelison. Each team had lost only

once in the tournament, and it was to each other!

The games were played back to back, and Kosciusko won the game 6-1, but it was 1-1 through the third inning, said Coach Cornelison. After that, "the ball just seemed to bounce their way the rest of the game," he explained.

"They won, but they respect Iuka now, just like we respect Kosciusko," he said.

That's a good thing, since they may meet again, soon. Both will play in the Mississippi State Tournament in Hattiesburg next week. Iuka is ranked second seed, below Kosciusko. Third seed Cleveland rounds out the North Half representatives to the state tournament.

Representing the South Half will be three of the following teams: Pascagoula, Lawrence County, Lincoln County or the Laurel Nationals. The championship of the South Half was being played at presstime.

"I promise we will put up a fight," said Cornelison. "We are really proud of the way they have represented our city. Their goal has been to win state, and that goal hasn't changed."

"We want to thank the people

of Iuka for their support, we have had many calls and messages of encouragement," said Cornelison. "And we've got great parents - they have been there every step, and kept the boys motivated."

"Thanks to all our coaches - Phillip Pritchard and Dale Wadkins, and we've had lots more help every step of the way. High school guys have come out to help, and businesses are helping out with the mounting expenses," said Cornelison.

When they go to Hattiesburg next week, the All-Star team will have a chance to work out at the University of Southern Mississippi field, with Southern Miss coach Richy Harrelson, who played at Tishomingo County High School and University of Mississippi.

Iuka friends and family will have a chance to give the team a big league send-off this Friday. The team and parents, friends and family will meet at the Iuka Middle School parking lot at 9 a.m. They will have a police escort as they caravan south down Battleground Drive, so supporters can wave them on their way, and show them how proud we are of them!

## Board Will Seek Bond Issue to Fund Jail

The Tishomingo County Board of Supervisors will be seeking to levy a bond issue to pay for a new \$5.2 million county jail, instead of using a lease-purchase loan plan as they had previously decided.

Board President James McDowell explained Monday at their regular third Monday meeting, that after consideration of the funding issues, it was found that the county could save about \$1.5 million if they raise the funds for the proposed new jail through a bond issue instead of the lease purchase loan.

"We just can't pass up saving \$1.5 million of the county's money," said McDowell. "The time frame is basically the same, and we are sure the contractors will be willing to help us on that."

Through the lease purchase loan, the board would be able, by state statute, to secure the funding without public hearing, but the interest would be about 4 - 4.85 percent, explained board attorney Philip Whitehead.

Through the bond issue process, the county pays 1 to 1.5 percent interest on the money, potentially saving \$1.5 million, said Whitehead.

With the lower interest rate comes a more democratic approach, Whitehead explained. The county must hold a public hearing on the issuance of bonds, publicized for three weeks in advance. If 1,500 or 20 percent of qualified electors submit a petition protesting the issuance of the bonds at that hearing, it has to go to a county vote, and it must pass by three-fifths majority.

McDowell said the date for the hearing would be announced

soon.

In other county business, First District Supervisor Brandon Grissom reported that the TAP Alliance, an economic development alliance of Tishomingo, Alcorn, and Prentiss counties established earlier this year, is going well. They are awaiting payment of about \$38,000 in grant money from ARC (Appalachian Regional Commission) that will provide for a study of the counties and what industries would be a good fit. The study group would then help the TAP Alliance market itself throughout the county, explained Grissom.

The board voted to continue their sponsorship of the Tishomingo County High School football game broadcasts on 91.9 FM at the request of the TC Touchdown Club at a cost of \$250. They also approved an ad for the TCHS football program at a cost of \$100.

The board approved an update to the courthouse computer systems.

The board approved a \$9,000 relocation of a 3-phase power line at Tri-State Park to accommodate an expansion at G&G Steel.

Tishomingo County Sheriff reported that the jail garden had a harvest of more than 80 gallons of purple hull peas, which have been harvested and preserved by the prisoners.

The board asked purchasing clerk Lynn West to get quotes on improving the efficiency of the air-conditioning at the Tishomingo County fairgrounds building.

The board approved \$450 to strip and re-paint the curbs at the courthouse to increase visibility.

## Authorities Arrest Repeat Offender on Meth Charges

Less than one month after being arrested in Lowndes County, for possession of meth, Billy Don Hall of Tishomingo was arrested by the Tishomingo County Sheriff's Department July 14th for possession of meth with intent to sell in Tishomingo County.

According to the sheriff's department, the arrest occurred at a residence on County Road 958. Hall was also under a Tishomingo County Grand Jury indictment for possession of precursors with intent to manufacture methamphetamine, and possession of methamphetamine.

Based on the information gathered during Hall's arrest on County Road 958, the Tishomingo County Sheriff's Department executed a search warrant at the residence of Tobi Hall, located at 924 Highway 30. According to Sheriff Whitlock, as a result of the search warrant, Tobi Hall, Dennis Dwayne McCarley and Billy Don Hall were arrested for possession of two or more precursors with the intent to manufacture methamphetamine, and conspiracy to manufacture methamphetamine.

Billy Don Hall and McCarley were also charged with conspiracy to distribute methamphetamine. McCarley is currently out on bond from Alcorn County for possession of a controlled substance. McCarley was arrested after purchasing pseudoephedrine with the intent to manufacture methamphetamine.

Cynthia Coggins was also arrested at the residence for possession of methamphetamine.

Billy Don Hall was already out on bond from the arrest in Lowndes County, and is current-

ly on probation with MDOC for possession of precursors with the intent to manufacture methamphetamine in Monroe County. There is another sentence running consecutively in Alabama for possession of methamphetamine. The MDOC has placed a hold on Hall and has filed a petition to impose a suspended sentence of twenty years.

The Tishomingo County Sheriff's Department seized \$622 in currency and a 1997 Chevrolet Yukon during the arrests.

## Shooting Victim Hospitalized

On July 14th, a man was shot and hospitalized as a result of an argument over the cutting of a tree.

According to Tishomingo County Sheriff Glenn Whitlock, Shawn Johnson was shot in the stomach area with a .38 caliber handgun, apparently after a struggle with Larry Stoop, 77, in the Brown's Hollow area, on County Road 454.

The argument reportedly had something to do with the cutting of a tree, but few details were available.

Stoop was charged with aggravated assault and was released on \$5,000 bond to await the action of the next grand jury.

### Phelps Seeks to Provide Other Side of Story

In light of the recent articles and editorials published in the local newspapers, I feel compelled to provide the other side of story pertaining to Tri State Educational Foundation and Riverhills Bingo. Tri State Educational Foundation and Riverhills Bingo

were formed by me and my previous in-laws, Bob and Sylvia Ferguson.

The fact is, 11 years ago I relocated to Iuka and I worked day and night to start Tri State Educational Foundation and Riverhills Bingo or it would not exist today. I, alone, operated Tri State Educational Foundation and set up a charitable gaming facility at its inception. The Fergusons involvement was to review grant requests from time to time and on occasion attend speaking engagements as that was as much as they wanted to do. I served as the executive director of Tri State Educational Foundation, Michael Cannon was the bingo supervisor, and Steve Knight served as alternate supervisor. Michael Cannon was responsible for the operations of Riverhills Bingo, not I. However, I did oversee gaming activity and the paper work assuring state laws and gaming regulations were adhered to; along with all financial reports and gaming audits to assure the best interest of Tri State Educational Foundation. I grew Tri State Educational Foundation from \$0 to approximately \$7 million dollars over the last ten and a half years. I also reviewed and made recommendations on all scholarships issued from Tri State Educational Foundation to the Board on which the Fergusons served as chairman and secretary. Please understand the following at the time of my departure, approximately 1.6 million dollars was left to Tri State Educational Foundation. Of the 1.6 million, approximately 1.2 million should remain available for students currently on scholarship. Once a student is issued a scholarship, money is moved from Tri State Educational Foundation's general fund to a special scholarship account. Money is only issued from the scholarship account to honor obligations over the course of the terms of an awarded scholarship. All current scholarship recipients funds were secure at my departure from Tri State Educational Foundation. I personally submitted the necessary college paper work and funding for the fall 2010 semester before my departure. The only possible reason any student currently on scholarship would lose their funding is if the Fergusons decided to pull it or not honor it. Tri State Educational Foundation was left financially secure. I am very proud of the work I have been so blessed to do for this community and surrounding communities over the years.

To address another rumor regarding where and how funds are being distributed, I would like to point out that a significant amount of funds received by Tri State Educational Foundation were in fact redirected by Mr. Ferguson to areas outside of our own community. Tri State Educational Foundation is named Tri State because it services the Tri State area of Alabama, Tennessee, and Mississippi.

Approximately four weeks prior to my resignation, I told Bob Ferguson I had several job offers and one in particular I was seriously considering. At no time prior to my resignation did Mr. Ferguson come to me and convey that he wanted me to stay or ask to work with me. Instead, the Fergusons

went after the organization that offered my employment with threats, political persuasion and intimidation. In an attempt to stop a charitable organization that has been established since 1975 from coming into this community, Mr. Ferguson went as far as to persuade and, in some cases, even threaten leaders such as The Iuka Board of Aldermen, city officials, members of Tishomingo County Schools Administration, Tishomingo County Sheriff, and County Supervisor. When these pressures were not successful, then Mr. Ferguson attempted to pressure the Mississippi Gaming Commission, State Representatives and a reported meeting with Governor Haley Barbour in an attempt to stop me from taking a job and implementing charitable programs in this community and throughout Northeast Mississippi.

To address rumors of Tri State Educational Foundation and Riverhills Bingo employees walking out; I want to be clear: all employees resigned on their own. I did address Tri State Educational Foundation and Riverhills Bingo employees with whom I had worked over the last ten and a half years to inform them that I was resigning from Tri State Educational Foundation due to personal issues with the Fergusons as well as disagreement with the direction the Foundation was going. My resignation letter to Bob and Sylvia Ferguson read as follows:

"It is with considerable reluctance that I am sending this letter. Although my time with Tri State Educational Foundation has been on the whole satisfying and productive, for quite a while now I have become less and less content with the situation. Decisions have been made that I disagree with, some of which have adversely and directly affected me personally. The direction of the Board and the new methods of accomplishing them are making it increasingly difficult for me to feel that I am contributing sufficiently.

Therefore, it is with regret that this letter serves as my resignation from Tri State Educational Foundation effective July 2, 2010."

At no time did I ever persuade anyone to leave Tri State Educational Foundation or Riverhills Bingo nor did I threaten anyone as persuasion to leave. Instead, I told them they all had my respect and appreciation for their years of hard work. I told them that if they needed a job I would love to work with them in the future. In talking with former Tri State and Riverhills Bingo employees, it was my understanding they were under pressure from the Fergusons which led to their resignations and therefore many sought employment with me. In fact, two key former Riverhills Bingo employees, one of three years and one of four years, told me that they did not have a clue who Mr. and Mrs. Ferguson were when they approached them concerning their employment there.

I am pleased to continue to have the opportunity to serve the local community as Administrative Director of the Mississippi Community Education Center. I can assure that Mississippi Community Education Center will support Northeast Mississippi families with educational, economic, and wellness programs as it has in many counties since 1975. Over the years, I have had many offers of employment. I choose MCEC because of their long

history of helping Mississippians and the fact that they were willing to put money in this community to benefit the people of this area. We will be offering student scholarship assistance and grants to schools and other community services. The Mississippi Community Education Center is also committed to expanding its childhood obesity prevention program to our area. Mississippi Community Education Center is a great asset to Northeast Mississippi and I am very proud to be a part of this organization.

### In Support of Riverhills

I am greatly disheartened at the opening of another bingo hall in Iuka. Northpoint Bingo is in direct competition with Riverhills Bingo, whose charity is Tri-State Educational Foundation. Tri-State is the brain-child of Dr. Bob Ferguson and his wife, Mrs. Sylvia Ferguson. When the Tishomingo County School system consolidated Dr. Ferguson was hired as superintendent and Mrs. Ferguson hired as a teacher. Upon retirement the Fergusons made Iuka their permanent home. As educators they realized that there was a great need for financial assistance to graduating seniors to attend college. Within the next few months Tri-State (Riverhills Bingo) will have dispersed \$7,000,000 (yes, that's seven million) in scholarships and grants for educational purposes to people in Tishomingo County and surrounding areas. It is likely that many of the individual recipients would not have been able to attend college without this financial assistance. In addition Tri-State supports Boys & Girls Club of Iuka, as well as other educational programs. As a member of the Boys & Girls Club Board of Directors, I can say first-hand that this support is very important to providing the services of the club.

My question is this - Why would anyone open a third bingo hall in Tisho-

mingo County? The population of Alcorn County (and Prentiss County) is more than double that of Tishomingo County and to my knowledge there is not a bingo hall in Alcorn County. Why not put the new bingo hall in one of those places? The only answer that I can come up with is "out of spite." Shawn Phelps is the former son-in-law of the Fergusons and he is the director of Northpoint Bingo. The charity of Northpoint is something called Mississippi Community Education Center BASED IN JACKSON, MS! Just how much of their profits will stay in Tishomingo County? No one seems to be able to provide a definite answer, all the while insisting that the money will stay "here." Where is "here?" I do know that MCEC supports "Summit School" and the tuition is \$7,500 per year, but I do not know where it is located or who attends this school. It is NOT in Tishomingo County! I'm not sure how much of the financial information will be made public nor what will be a matter of public record. I believe that once the money (profits) reaches the said charity, there is no individual accounting of where the money goes. These records are monitored by the

Secretary of State of Mississippi, but the public have to be given any information about who bears how much) other money was spent on

If you are a bingo player please continue to Riverhills Bingo. All profits from this stay in this area. Schools have been given to surrounding counties very large majority, Tishomingo County and programs. If you done so, please read the letters in the Tishomingo County

In closing, yes, the Fergusons are personal friends. I applaud them and their efforts to provide education for our people. It will be a very good thing for the students/people of our county if the money goes out of the Tishomingo County

Thank you for the time to read this letter. The State Educational Foundation has helped you or a member of your family, we please take the time to read a letter in support of education? Let everyone know how important this has been to you!
