County Schools Begin August 5th

School bells will ring throughout Tishomingo County Thursday, August 5th, as the 2010-2011 school year officially begins for students.

Teachers and school district personnel from all county schools will begin their year Monday morning at 8:00 as they gather in the TCHS auditorium to hear Dr. Burnham, State Superintendent of Education, address the assembly.

This is the second time Dr. Burnham has visited Tishomingo County High School since he was named Superintendent of Education. A native of Puckett, Miss., Dr. Burnham has served as Dean of the School of Education at the University of Mississippi; as MS Superintendent of Education from 1992 until 1997; Superintendent of Henderson County Public School in North Carolina; as Superintendent of the Jaxi School District; as Executive Director of the Gulf Coast Education Initiative Consortium; as Adjunct Associate Professor at the University of Southern Mississippi. He holds a doctorate in Curriculum and Instruction from Delta State University, as well as a bachelor's degree in Business Administration and master's in Educational Leadership from Mississippi College. He began his tenure as MS State Superintendent in 2009.

Tax Free Weekend In Mississippi

Businesses throughout Mississippi will be offering a Tax Free Weekend, on Friday, July 30th and Saturday, July 31st, to help parents buy back to school merchandise. Only clothing and shoes will be sold tax free on Friday and Saturday. Local businesses will be participating and some are advertising their specials in this issue of *The News*.

This is Mississippi's second year to participate in a sales tax holiday. There will be a \$100 limit per item. Layaways are not tax exempt. Only store coupons and discounts can be used to lower the price below the dollar limit. Manufacturer's coupons can't be used to bring the price below the threshold. Rain check purchases are only exempt if the item is bought during the sales tax holiday.

Fatal Accident In Itawamba County

At approximately 4:55 pm, Wednesday afternoon, the Mississippi Highway Patrol responded to a motor vehicle collision involving a semi-tractor trailer near the Fairview Community on MS 25 in Itawamba County. Upon arriving it appeared Jose Rigual III, 23, of Golden, was northbound driving a 1990 Lexus, when he apparently attempted to make a left turn onto Burnt Fields Road and pulled into the path of a southbound 1998 International Semi-Tractor and Trailer, operated by Joby Morgan, 36, of Booneville.

A passenger in Rigual's vehicle was killed as a result of the crash. Jasper Rigual, 5 months old, also of Golden, was pronounced dead at the scene. The infant was properly fastened in a child safety seat at the time of the crash.

Jose Rigual III was transported to North Mississippi Medical Center with non life-threatening injuries. He was wearing his seat belt.

Morgan was uninjured in the accident and was wearing a seat belt.

The crash disrupted traffic flow on MS 25 for approximately 2 hours. The accident remains under investigation by the Mississippi Highway Patrol.

MDEQ Awards Solid Waste Assistance Grant To Tishomingo County

The Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) has awarded Tishomingo County a solid waste assistance grant of \$9,246 that will be used by the county for cleanup of unauthorized dump sites.

"The Solid Waste Assistance Grants support a variety of useful solid waste management activities for cities and counties. We are pleased this grant is available to assist the efforts of Tishomingo County in improving their management of solid waste," said Trudy Fisher, MDEQ Executive Director.

Cities and counties may apply for Solid Waste Assistance Grants through the Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality. These grants are utilized by local communities for programs to prevent and clean up unauthorized dumps; to aid in hiring local solid waste enforcement officers; for public education efforts on solid waste disposal and recycling; and to establish programs for the collection of white goods, bulky wastes and recyclables.

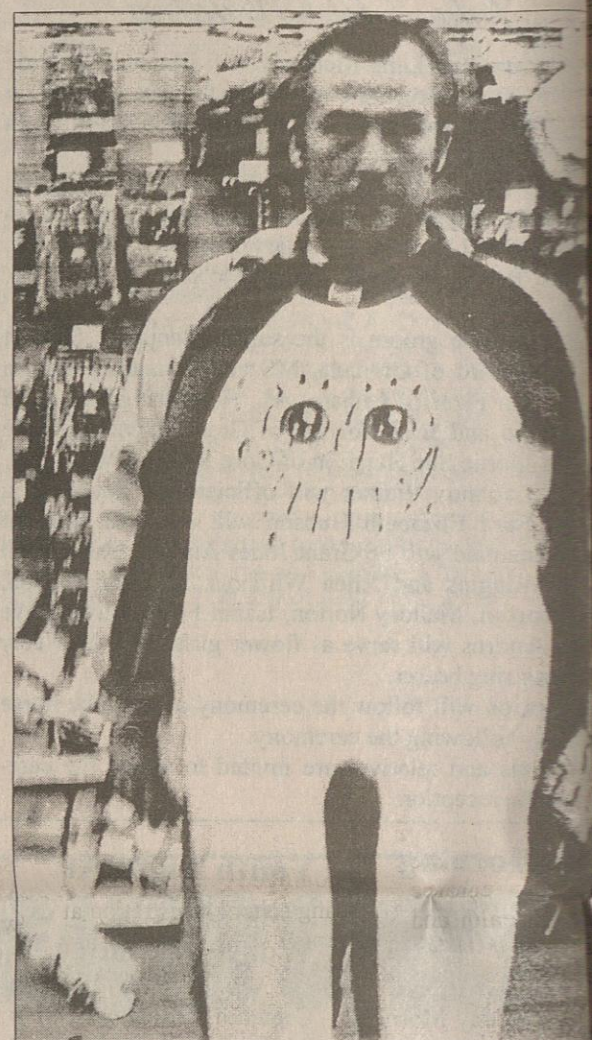

Old Remedies

Physicians were both in short supply or nonexistent in Mississippi's late 18th and 19th centuries. Therefore, our Mississippi pioneers had to do their own "doctoring." After reading the following cures, it might be easy to determine why life expectancy was rather short and infant mortality was extremely high. Of course, this is not a condemnation of our pioneers' remedies; it has been said that some of these remedies are still used with varying success by Mississippians. I will admit, however, that I have never had one of these remedies applied to me.

According to accounts in various diaries and the Works Projects Administration's Source Material for Mississippi Folklore, many older women became very skillful in doctoring and nursing the sick using herbs.

Generally, when there was sickness in a home, the neighbors would come and "set up" with the patient. Occasionally, "medicine men" or Indian doctors were called in for consultation. In fact, most of the herb remedies were learned from the Native Americans. Many homes had a "doctor book" which described symptoms and offered remedies for many diseases and ailments; most of the remedies were herbal. Below are a few of the remedies used by Mississippi's pioneer families:

Bowel Complaints—Rice browned in a skillet and boiled soft was the best "bowel comforter."

Colds—Hog hoof tea, mullein tea, golden rod tea, and wild onion poultices on the patient's chest were reputed to bring "fast relief" to suf-

ferers of the common cold.

Consumption—There were several methods for treating consumption. Perhaps the most unusual called for the patient to drink the warm blood from a freshly killed bull. If there was a reluctance to slaughter a bull, the warm milk of a red cow could be drunk; if possible, it was best to drink the warm milk of a heifer with her first calf.

Ear, Tooth, or Stomach Ache—For these various aches, heat was applied in hot water "bottles" made of dried pigs' bladders. Poultices of hot salt tied in a woolen bag or sock were also used to apply heat to the aching region.

Headache—Cedar limbs and elder leaves were placed together in warm water and then applied to the forehead to relieve headaches.

Infectious Disease—Assafetida tied in a little sack and hung about a child's neck or sewed into his underwear was believed to prevent such infectious diseases such as measles.

Kidney Trouble—Black wa-

termelon seed mashed up and boiled into tea was a common remedy for ailing kidneys.

Lumbago—The cure for lumbago was relatively simple—just wear a snake-skin belt.

Malaria—Malaria was sup-

posedly caused by breaking up the soil and cutting timber. Both of these tasks caused a decay of vegetable matter, and this decaying matter produced congestive chills and fevers. Pioneers believed that trees planted around a house would keep out the malaria because the leaves would catch the fever—carrying mists which rose up from the swamps and low places. Pioneers also believed that bathing in sun-warmed water was good for chills; that whiskey, in which dogwood bark was steeped, was a sure cure for chills and fever; and that poultices of the leaves of the castor bean would relieve the headaches caused by malarial fever.

Nosebleed—If afflicted with a nosebleed, a patient was advised to hold a kernel of

red corn on his nose. If this failed, the bleeding could be stopped by allowing some of the blood to drip onto an axe or knife which was then buried in the ground.

Nightmares—A full night's sleep, uninterrupted by nightmares, could be obtained by placing a fork under the pillow.

Rheumatism—There were two cures for rheumatic pains. Most considered pole cat grease as the best cure. Others believed that relief could be obtained by carrying a buckeye in the pocket.

Snakebite—Certain herbs were always carried in the pocket against snakebite. One cure was fern snake-root, wild horehound, and wild plantain or St. Andrew's cross. If bitten by a snake, the unfortunate victim would chew a quantity of any of these roots, swallow a part of it, and apply some of the chewed root to the wound. This procedure was repeated in proportion to the poison of the snake. However, competent medical personnel were very outspoken in their opposition

of this remedy.

"Sore Mouth" in Children—There were several cures for children afflicted with "sour mouth." These included putting a piece of pine top up the chimney (when the pine branch withered, the child would be cured); rubbing the mouth with the leaves of a white oak, and then crossing two white oak sticks in the mouth; and tying up a lock of the child's hair.

Splinters—To "draw out" a splinter, the pioneer bound a piece of fat meat to the afflicted part.

Worms in Animals—Ripe chinaberries were administered to animals afflicted with worms.

Worms in Children—Jerusalem oak tea, made from the roots of the plant, was the most popular home remedy for children afflicted by worms.

In conclusion, many Mississippi pioneers felt that it was best to get your head good and wet in the first rain of the month. In the event you did not become ill, you would enjoy both health and happiness for the remainder of the year.
