### Tennessee Man Stabbed at Steel Bridge During Altercation Sunday

A Corinth man has been charged with aggravated assault following an apparent stabbing at the Old Steel Bridge fishing area last Sunday afternoon.

Cory Bray, 26, of Corinth has been released on \$5,000 bond after being charged with aggravated assault, according to Tishomingo County Sheriff Glenn Whitlock. The charges were the result of an altercation between Bray and Benjamin Brown, 20, of Middle-  
ton, Tennessee.

According to eyewitness accounts, said Whitlock, Bray and

Brown got into a fight near the water, and eventually the fight moved into the water, where Brown was stabbed in the chest. Reportedly, Bray was concealing a knife inside the cast on his broken arm, said Whitlock.

County Deputies and officers with the Mississippi Department of Wildlife, Fisheries and Parks were on routine patrol in the area, and intercepted a vehicle with the injured Brown. Brown was then taken by ambulance for treatment, said Whitlock.

The incident is still under investigation.

### Two Indicted for 2009 Holt Murder

The suspects in the 2009 murder of John Holt have been indicted, and will be arraigned soon, reported authorities this week.

Linda Holt and her daughter, Terry L. Sparks, 32, have been charged, and now indicted, with the murder of 84-year-old John Holt, and are being held without bond, said Tishomingo County Sheriff Glenn Whitlock Tuesday. The two face arraignment June 29th in Tishomingo County Circuit Court.

Linda Holt has been in custody in Prentiss County, but will soon return to the Tishomingo County Jail, when Sparks moves to a facility in Rankin County, said Whitlock.

In March, after fifteen months of investigation into the brutal beating death of the elderly Burnsville man, investigators finally got a break in the case and arrested Holt for the crime.

Linda Holt is the widow of John Holt's adopted son, Wen-

dell, who is deceased, explained family members.

Several coincidental events happened following the Holt murder.

January 21, 2010, Linda Holt and her daughter, Terry L. Sparks, 32, were arrested by Corinth Police for uttering a forgery, when they tried to cash a check written on John Holt's account, and another where the \$40 amount had been altered to \$140 on a check from Holt's account, according to reports at the time.

February 28th of 2010, firefighters responded to a fire at the former home of John Holt. Another family was living there at the time, and all escaped safely from the early Sunday morning fire.

The state fire investigator ruled that fire accidental.

#### Other Indictments

The two indictments are among many that were recently handed down, said Whitlock.

### Golden Eagle Shot in Tishomingo County; \$2,500 Reward Offered

IUKA, Miss. (AP) — Federal and state wildlife agencies are offering a \$2,500 reward for information in the shooting of a golden eagle in the Iuka area of Tishomingo County.

Authorities say an eagle was discovered in the North Crossroads community near Tishomingo County Road 306. The investigation revealed the eagle was shot between March 15 and April 7. It had a bullet in its left wing, and due to its injuries, the bird could not have flown far from where it

was shot.

The two-year-old golden eagle is currently undergoing rehabilitation at the Jackson Zoo. Authorities say it possibly will not fly again.

Golden eagles are protected by both federal and state wildlife laws. Violations of these laws carry maximum criminal penalties of up to \$100,000 and/or one year in federal prison.

### Register Now to Vote in 2011 Primary and General Elections

Last week, the NAACP appealed the Federal Court decision to give our elected lawmakers another year to finish the redistricting process to the United States Supreme Court. July 2, 2011: Voter registration

deadline for the Primary Election. Circuit Clerk's offices will be open from 8 am to noon.

July 30, 2011: Last day for absentee balloting in person in the primary election. Circuit Clerk's office will remain open until noon.

August 2, 2011: Primary Election. Polls open from 7 am to 7 pm.

### Daylily Season in the South

around Tishomingo County, you can enjoy the blooms of daylilies like these in the garden of Steve and Veneda Nicholson on Old Highway 72.

Daylilies, or *Hemerocallis*, are perennial beauties that can be found growing everywhere in the South. They are available in a wide variety of colors, and adaptable

enough to grow in cultivated gardens, along garden borders, and even in ditches throughout Mississippi. As a bonus, after a few seasons, they multiply themselves enough to fill a border, or separate and share with friends.

The word *Hemerocallis* is derived from two Greek words meaning "beauty" and "day," re-

ferring to the fact that each flower lasts only one day. To make up for this, there are many flower buds on each daylily flower stalk, and many stalks in each clump of plants, so, the flowering period of a clump is usually several weeks long. And, many cultivars have more than one flowering period.

### Waterfalls & Pickwick Lake Immortalized in 2011 IUMW Collectible Ornament

The Iuka United Methodist Women's organization has announced the 2011 edition of its collectible ornament series, featuring the Anna Waterfalls on the Pickwick Lake.

The hand-made stained-glass ornaments will feature the 50-foot Anna Falls that are about a half-mile downstream of J.P. Coleman Park. The popular destination for water enthusiasts is located in a large cove on Pickwick Lake, which has become a major attraction for Tishomingo County since the late 1930s. It has been immortalized in song by the Pickwick, Tennessee, though he calls them Yellow Creek waterfall.

The Lake is the reservoir created by the Pickwick Landing Dam. The Lake runs 53 miles from the dam in Tennessee to the Shoals area below Wilson, Alabama. Construction began in 1934 as part of a New Deal initiative, and is part of the Tennessee Valley Authority,

and the Tennessee-Tombigbee Waterway System. The dam was completed in 1938 and created 47,500 acres of fresh water for fishing and water sports. It's nearly 490 miles of winding shoreline offer recreational, vacation and residential housing for hundreds of families, and helps make Tishomingo County one of the premier vacation destinations in Mississippi.

According to a release from the IUMW, Pickwick Landing Dam gets its name from the nearby town of Pickwick, Tennessee. The origin of the name Pickwick comes from a riverboat stop dating from the 1840s. White Sulphur Springs was the first name of Pickwick Landing. However, its postmaster renamed the community for his favorite book, the 1830s novel, "The Pickwick Papers," by Charles Dickens.

Each ornament is hand tinted and kiln fired by North Carolina artist Tina Steenerson. They are



edged in copper.

The ornaments are available for \$20 each, and will be here in about 2 weeks. 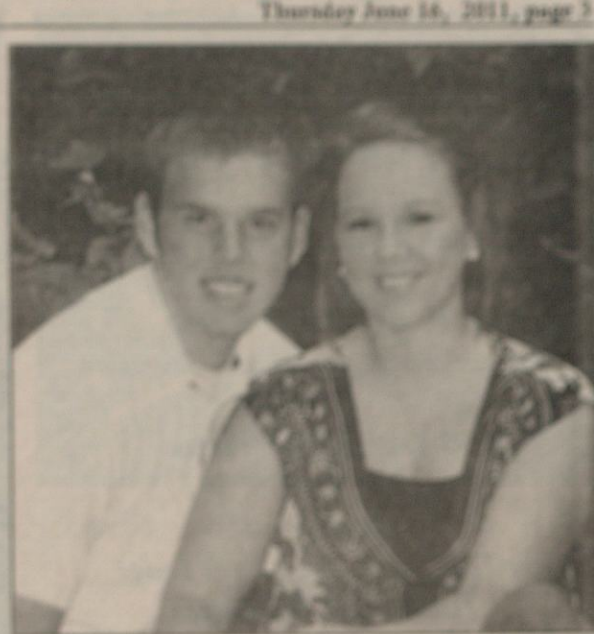

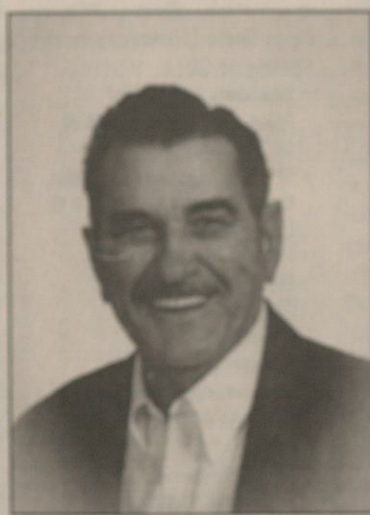

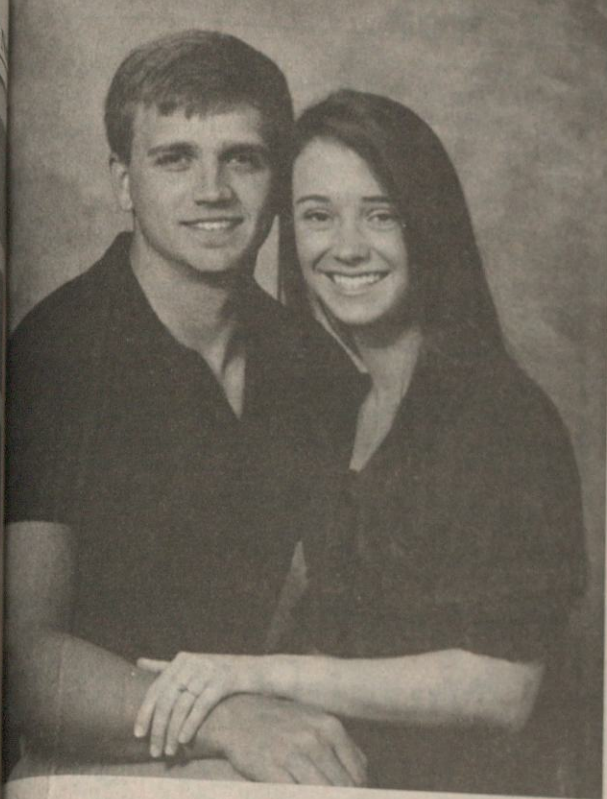

### Still Needs Signatures

I would like to thank all of you 2,569 people that signed the petition. The only problem is there were only 1,743 good. There were 826 rejected names. There were 454 people that signed this petition that were not registered to vote. I sent all of those people a letter explaining that their names did not match. It cost me \$900 to mail all these letters. I would appreciate if the 454 people would go to the circuit clerk's office in the Tishomingo County Courthouse and register to vote so that you can sign the petition legally. If you know anyone that is 18 and older and are not registered to vote, please encourage them to do so. They cannot buy alcohol until they are 21 years of age, but they are allowed to vote at the age of 18. If alcohol gets voted in Tishomingo, the people that are under 21 years of age might have a good job to go to when they do get old enough to buy alcohol. This is the young people's future. If there aren't any jobs created in Tishomingo County, there won't be any young people here to keep it going on. They are all coming of age to work and leaving the county. In another twenty years from now, all of the elders will be died out and gone on. It's either going to become a ghost town or just a retirement town. How will the town survive on just retired people? When you have no working people in the county, you will not have any tax dollars. We will be like these other little counties. First the post office will close down, then banks, fast food and restaurants will close down, because there won't be enough money in circulation to keep them open.

People that are drawing retirement checks, social security, SSI, and Welfare are not going to have enough money to spend in these places to keep them open, without jobs in a county it has no tax dollars. All of the people that say that the crime rate will go up if alcohol is sold in Tishomingo County need to go talk to a county or a city that has went wet. They will tell you since they've gone wet, their crime rate dropped 30 to 40 percent.
