sure vessels for oil refineries, power plants, chemical plants and more. They also have operations in Holly Springs, where the company employs 125 workers.

was arrested on a capias warrant for sale of marijuana.

Michael Dees, age 54 of Iuka, was arrested on a capias warrant for sale of hydrocodone.

Sheriff Whitlock would also wish to state that the sale of counterfeit substance in now considered a felony as of July 1<sup>st</sup>. The crime was a misdemeanor in the past and the legislature upgraded the crime to a felony. An example would be if a person sold a substance like a vitamin, claiming it to be hydrocodone, it would have been a misdemeanor. The crime is now a felony.

The Sheriff's Department has also arrested Robert Grindle, 23, of Iuka, for credit card fraud and burglary of the Iuka Gospel Chapel. A credit card and cash was stolen from the chapel.

The sheriff's department is investigating several recent reports of counterfeit currency being passed in local businesses in the county. The US Secret Service is assisting in the investigation.

 Be it further resolved that the Circuit Clerk for Tishomingo County, Mississippi shall take all action necessary to place the referendum on the November 6, 2012, General Election Ballot to allow the voters of Tishomingo County, Mississippi to approve or deny the implementation of said tax as described in House Bill 1551 as signed into law by the Governor. The Circuit Clerk shall publish said Referendum Election on the Tourism Tax in advance of said election as required by the Statute being once a week for at least three consecutive weeks in a paper published or having general circulation within Tishomingo County, Mississippi with the first publication of the notice to be made not less than twenty-one (21) days before the date fixed in the resolution for the election and the last publication being not more than seven (7) days before the election. Additionally, the referendum on the 1% Tourism Tax to be implemented, if approved by the Voter's, shall be in the form as prescribed by the Statute and shall read, "For the Tax" and "Against the Tax" to allow voters to clearly identify their intentions on the ballot when cast.  
 Be it further resolved that the Tishomingo County Board Attorney shall submit this resolution of Intent to Impose 1% Tourism Tax and the Referendum Election thereon to the United States Justice Department - Voting Rights Division for pre-approval as provided by the Voting Rights Act of 1965, as annotated and amended.
