School Investigating Making Up Extra Days

Tishomingo County School Superintendent Christie Holly said that the state will soon determine if students will have to make up the six days they have missed so far for bad weather.

Only one makeup day was built into the calender this school year, confirmed Holly, so students will not get off April 6th, referred to sometimes as "Good Monday." The students will still have an extra week to make up at this point. According to Mississippi state law, students have to attend school 180 days each school year.

But, says Holly, the district and others have applied to the state board of education to grant a waiver for the missed days.

Some county parents and students have been frustrated by calls cancelling school the night

before, in anticipation of bad road conditions. Several of those days have perversely turned out to be fairer than expected, with fine conditions.

"It is frustrating to try to predict, but we go with the latest meterorological forecasts and try to make the safest call on behalf of our students," explained Holly. "The main roads and highways are clear for travel, but we have to think about those potentially icy back roads. It's not so much our seasoned bus drivers we worry about, but teen drivers who aren't experienced

The district hopes to have a decision soon on the snow days. Icy weather moving through the Tennessee Valley late Wednesday could mean another "snow day" Thursday.


