## Tennessee Woman Dies from Exposure Thanksgiving Day

A tragic turn of events leaves an elderly woman from Michie, TN dead of exposure on Thanksgiving morning.

Stella Poindexter, 75, was found around 8:00 a.m. lying in the road on Hwy. 364 near the Holcut Memorial in Tishomingo County by a hunter who came upon her and called 911. According to Tishomingo County Coroner, Mack Wilemon, she was pronounced dead at the Iuka Hospital. It appeared the cause of her death was exposure to the elements; she had apparently been outside all night in 23 degree weather, with no shoes.

Further investigation found that Mrs. Poindexter was traveling in a vehicle with her husband Herschel Poindexter, 84, on Wednesday

exter had spent Tuesday night in the Corinth Hospital for a procedure and the couple left the hospital Wednesday afternoon headed back to Michie, but did not return home.

Coroner, Wilemon believes that Mrs. Poindexter fell while attempting to walk to find help or acquire a cell signal. Given that Holcut is a rural area, it is difficult to send or receive phone calls. He stated that the family of the Poindexter's had been attempting to reach the couple to no avail. Mrs. Poindexter was found in the road 3/10's of a mile away from the vehicle.

Funeral services for Mrs. Poindexter were held November 28th at Magnolia Funeral Home in Corinth, MS.

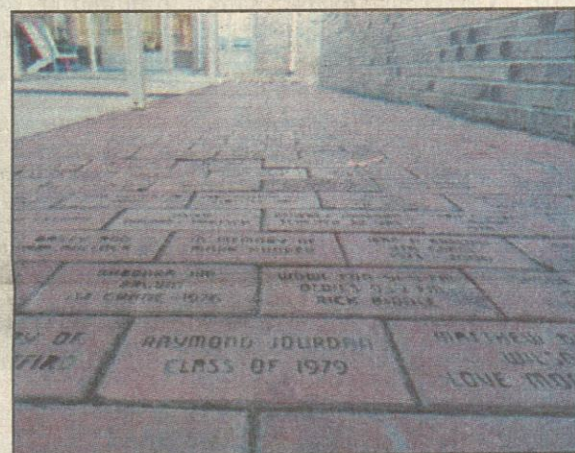
## TCHS Offering Legacy Brick Project to Honor Students or Remember Loved Ones

## Retired Tishomingo County Extension Agent, Danny Owen, Dies

Danny Oneal Owen, 60, of Golden, died Tuesday, November 21, 2017, at the Red Bay Hospital following an apparent heart attack. A much loved and respected leader in Tishomingo County, Danny came to the Tishomingo County Extension Service in 1991 after working in Benton County. He retired in 2015 from the Mississippi State University Extension Service following 30 years of helping Mississippi farmers and youth.

Although he had retired to spend time with his family, he remained active in local clubs and projects. He was always cheerful and kind and even after retirement, continued to enjoy working with people in many areas. He served as the County Coordinating Agent for the Extension Service in Iuka; was active with the Tishomingo County Farm Bureau where he served as board vice-president; and served as president of the Mississippi Master Gardeners and was active in the Tishomingo County Master Gardeners.

He was a board member with the County Fair and will

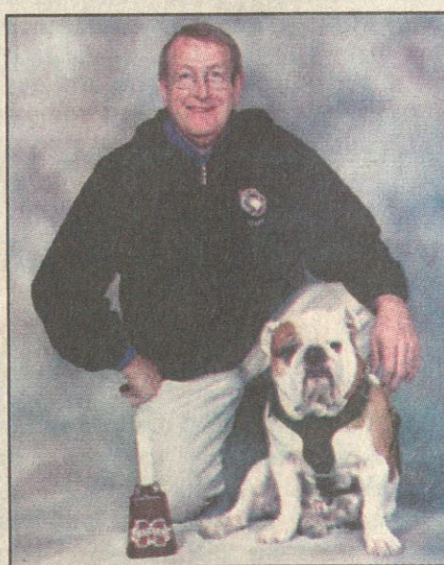
always be remembered for his devotion to the fair, helping to make it more enjoyable and educational each year.

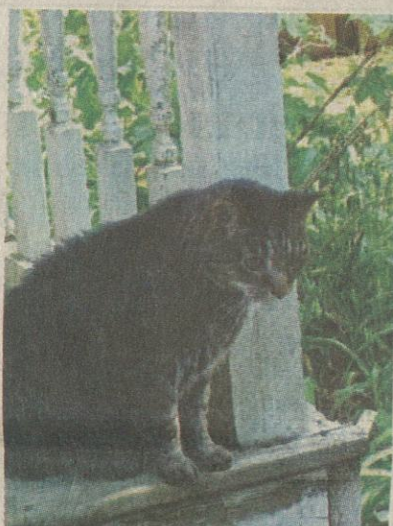

## Pet of the Week

Congratulations to Tom Byars! This loveable feline is our pet of the week at Iuka Animal Clinic. This is what his owner Catherine Byars has to say about him. Tom came to live with me and my little dog, Shaggy in late summer. One day I heard Shaggy barking without stopping in the backyard and went out to check. There, all huddled up against the fence was a cat. Shaggy wasn't trying to hurt the cat, but I suppose alert me to the danger. I finally felt comfortable enough to hold him and brought him to my deck. It was through watching him on the steps and seeing how he got around all the furniture that I realized that he was blind, I thought. I immediately called Dr. Perkin's office and asked if they would check him out. It was determined that he was a healthy 6 to 7 year-old cat who was blind. I didn't have a name for him, so the office named

him, Tom. I have a grown son who is named Thomas and I asked if he cared that the cat was named Tom and he said he was fine with it as long as the cat spelled his name differently from him! So we do. Tom is able to get around the back yard without any problems. He did get lost one day on the side but when I realized that he was not where he usually is I started calling his name and he "meowed" back and came very swiftly to me. He does not run, but can get somewhere fast if he needs to. We decided on a place for his food and water bowl and he lets me know when it is time to eat - all the time. It took a while, but we have also decided on the brand of food and snacks that he likes. This winter he has a tent on the deck that he can get in and out of easily and



his own heater that runs at night. Tom is a sweet cat, learning to trust, and puts up with the dog, Shaggy. I think cats know dogs even if they cannot see them. I have seen Tom following the dog in the yard as he has been learning his way around. Dr. Perkins says that the cat has his own seeing eye dog! Tom and Shaggy get along well as brothers. Tom is a very precious cat.

Disabled pets are incredible. In fact, sometimes they pull off tremendous heroic and athletic feats! Blind, one-eyed, deaf and three-legged pets can live full happy lives - just spend some time with one and you'll see how much they can enjoy a wide range of activities and certainly can give just as much love as any pet. Puppies and kittens who are born with a disability, or acquire it early in life, have no idea they're different, and even adult and older pets can most often adapt to disabilities that humans would find hard to manage. They simply adapt and frolic on. If you are considering adopting a pet, you might want to consider one of these amazing animals.

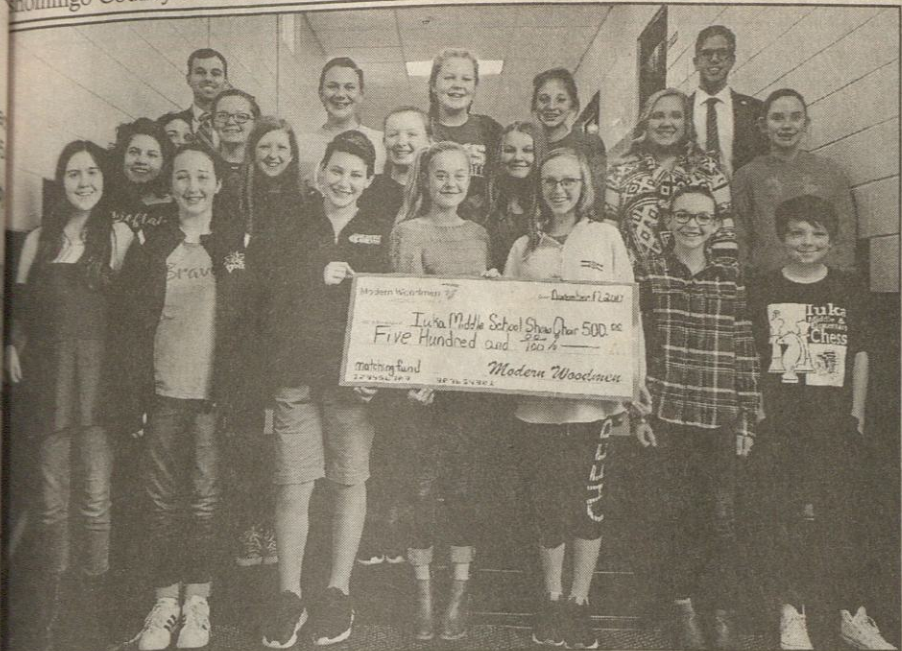

## Shoe Store in Iuka

This photo (at right) was found in my photos at home. On the back it reads, "maybe Ben McRae Shoe Store next to Iuka Guaranty Bank." In researching I found that Ben F. McRae, Jr. died in 1957. In the August 1, 1957 issue of *The Vidette* an interesting story appeared on page 1. "Bank Now In Temporary Location" This morning (Thursday) the Iuka Guaranty Bank opened for business in temporary quarters that will be used during the remodeling of the bank building. Banking business is now being done in the old city hall across Eastport street from the Post Office. Iuka Guaranty Bank is enlarging its floor space with the addition of the building formerly occupied by McRae's shoe store. In addition to the added space new equipment will be installed along with improved banking facilities that will increase the service of the local institution.

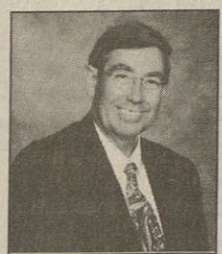


# The Judgment of the One World Church (part VII)

In the last article we saw a beast who ascends out of the bottomless pit. Now we will see that he "was, is not, and shall ascend out of the bottomless pit" (Revelation 17:8). This seems to mean that the beast was someone who lived and ruled on the earth before, or it may mean that he will live and reign in the tribulation; will be killed and will arise from the dead and the bottomless pit. Whatever the case, he reigns more than once in the revived Roman empire, for Revelation 17:11 says of him, "And the beast that was, and is not, even he is the eighth, and is of the seven, and goeth into perdition." Revelation 17:9-10 will help us fill in the gap: "And here is the

mind which hath wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains, on which the woman sitteth. And there are seven kings: five are fallen, and one is, and the other is not yet come; and when he cometh, he must continue a short space." So, the antichrist (called the beast here) will be someone who reigns as a seventh world ruler; he will be killed and he will arise to reign as the eighth world ruler, but he is actually the 7th ruler revived from the dead and restored to his kingdom. If this is

too hairy for some readers, may I say that it is hairy for all of us, but we must understand it as much as we can. I can speculate with the best, perhaps, so I am saying that I, and several after whom I have read, am speculating here. We can clearly see four world empires in Daniel chapters two and seven, and this is no speculation, for these are shown to rule until Christ comes to rule, but their rule starts with Nebuchadnezzar in Daniel's day. So, there is a speculation that the

seven kings include these four with perhaps three earlier empires, namely that of Egypt, Syria and Assyria. This speculation could, of course, be right, but it could be wrong. Others have seen Egypt and Assyria as two earlier world empires, with Babylon, Media-Persia, the Greek empire and the Roman empire, which gives a total of six. Then the revived Roman empire under the antichrist is counted as the seventh, with the antichrist being killed and raised again to be the eighth world ruler. He would be of the seven, as our verses say, for he will be both the seventh and the eighth world ruler. It is not imperative that we understand all of this in detail, for likely none of

us does!

The big thing to recognize in Revelation chapter 17 is that there is a "whore" who rides on the back of this 8th world ruler during the tribulation, at least for a time, but then she is thrown off and destroyed. This is where we get the idea of the "judgment of the one-world church". Some might say that this is not a "church", but the meaning of the word "church" is: "a called out assembly", and there is at least that fact in our chapter. I think this assembly will be made up of the world's religions in the tribulation, with one big religious movement heading it up, thus the term "one world church". Keep in mind that I am not "speaking

from Sinai", for I claim to know all that is being said but I have made some deductions from what is written, and from the testimony of those who have written on this subject. The beast is said to come from Revelation 17:10, and we have seen that his reign is basically half of the tribulation, three and one half years, but it is in the middle of that treaty that breaks it and causes his sacrifices to cease.

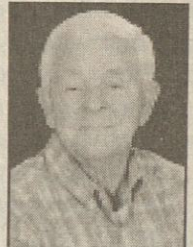

**Shiloh Battlefield to Conduct Prescribed Burns**

Shiloh National Military Park will conduct a prescribed burn in the early December. Park staff, with assistance from the Natchez Trace Parkway Fire Management Team, will burn the East Branch Zone/Lost Field area. The East Branch Unit is a 232-acre unit bordered by Hamburg-Purdy Road to the north, Eastern Corinth Road to the east, Corinth Road to the west, and Peabody Road to the south.

Prescribed fire is a beneficial and cost-effective tool for managing several forest types, as well as grasslands. Historically, fire has played a natural role in maintaining a healthy ecosystem. A controlled burn reduces the build-up of dead woody debris and non-native vegetation, decreases risk of catastrophic wildfire, and

provides habitat and forage for animals. This year park management aims to begin the burn in early December, and it may occur anytime in the following winter months, with weather conditions being the determining factor.

Warning signs will be placed along the border roads as a safety precaution to motorists and pedestrians. Motorists are expected to travel at a safe speed with their headlights on when smoke is present during the burn. They should also be alert for park rangers, wildland firefighters, and equipment along these roadways.

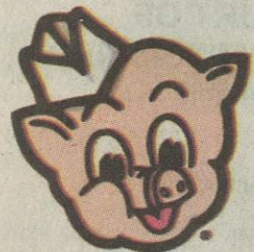

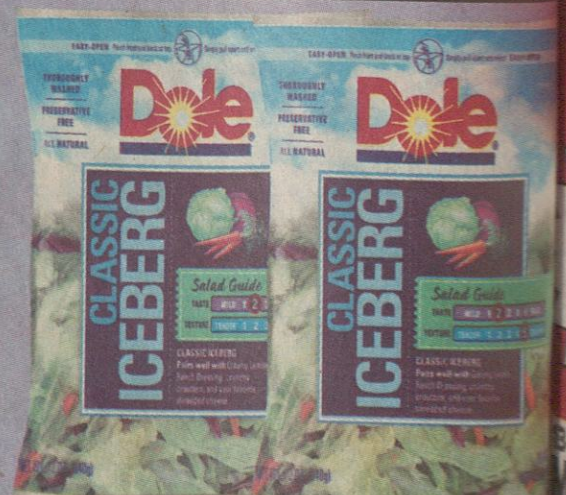
