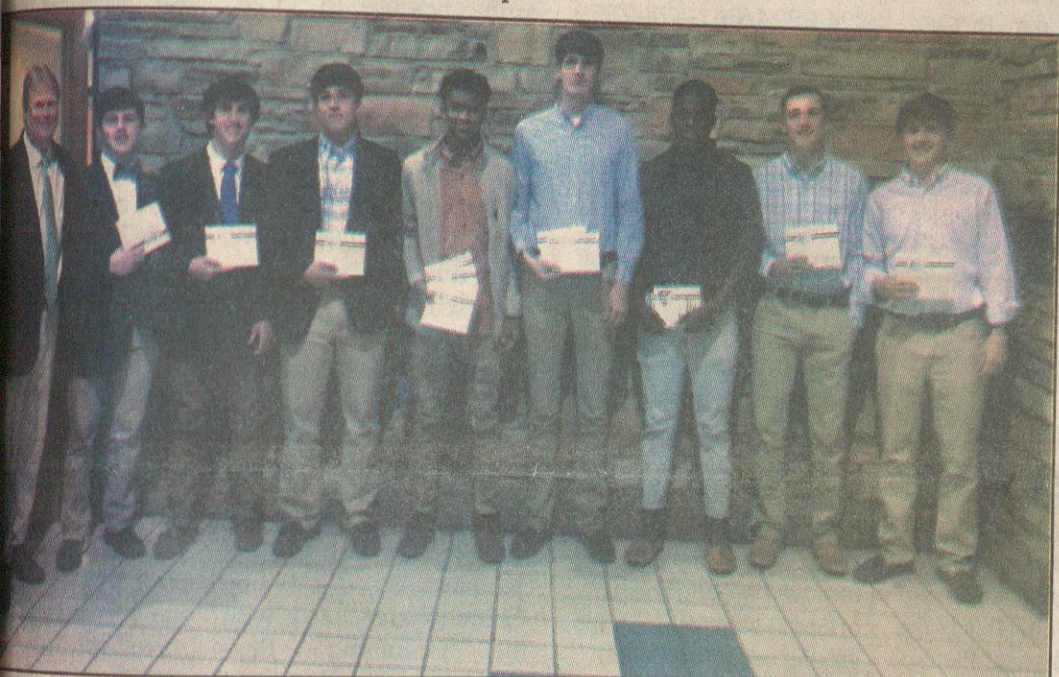

## Burglary Arrests Made Over Easter Holiday Weekend

The Tishomingo County Sheriff's Office recently made two arrests in connection with the reported burglaries at the Mill Creek Marina near Iuka.

Mark Anthony Michael and Jaret Ray Taylor were taken into custody. During the past several days, officials from the Sheriff's Department had received reports of numerous items which were stolen from some boats that were staged at the marina.

In the early morning hours of Friday, March, 30th Tishomingo County Sheriff's deputies conducted a traffic stop of a truck in the city limits of Iuka. During the course of the traffic stop, several firearms were found in the vehicle along with a "wig" and a camouflage gillie suit. The driver of the vehicle was recognized as a suspect in the recent case of theft in which some farming equipment was stolen. This, paired with the knowledge of the recent events that had occurred at the Mill Creek Marina, allowed the deputies to detain all of the individuals in the vehicle.

After further investigation, "permission to search" was granted from both of the suspects; their residences in Prentiss County were searched. Sheriff John Daugherty stated that his deputies and investigators were able to recover everything that has been reported stolen. Those that were charged are listed as follows:

Mark Anthony Michael, 43-year-old, white male of 252 CR 1021 Rienzi, Mississippi was officially charged with 7 counts of burglary of water

vessel. Michael's bond was set by the Justice Court at \$150,000. Currently the Tishomingo Sheriff's Office has filed paperwork with the District Attorney's Office to have Michael "held without bond" due to being out on a previous felony bond.

Jaret Ray Taylor, 46-year-old, white male of 342 CR 1251 Booneville, Mississippi, was also officially charged with 7 counts of burglary of water vessel and 1 count of possession of firearm by a convicted felon. Taylor's bond also was set by the Justice Court in the amount of \$150,000.

Sheriff Daugherty would like to thank the Iuka Police Department and the Prentiss County Sheriff's Office for their assistance in this case. Sheriff Daugherty would also like to let the public know how appreciative he is of his patrol deputies being proactive in situations like this, "You never know what that deputy is going to come across every time a traffic stop is made. I am very fortunate to have officers like this, not only working for this department but protecting Tishomingo County as well."

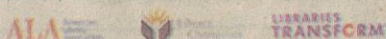

### Airman Austin Whitfield Graduates from Basic Training

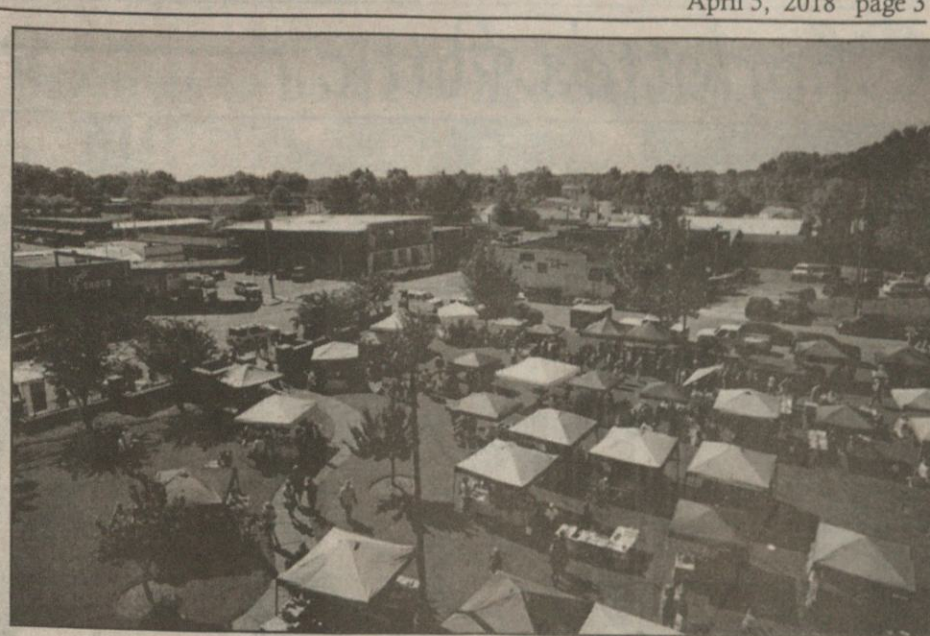
U.S. Air Force Airman Austin Whitfield graduated from basic military training at Joint Base San Antonio-Lackland, San Antonio, Texas.

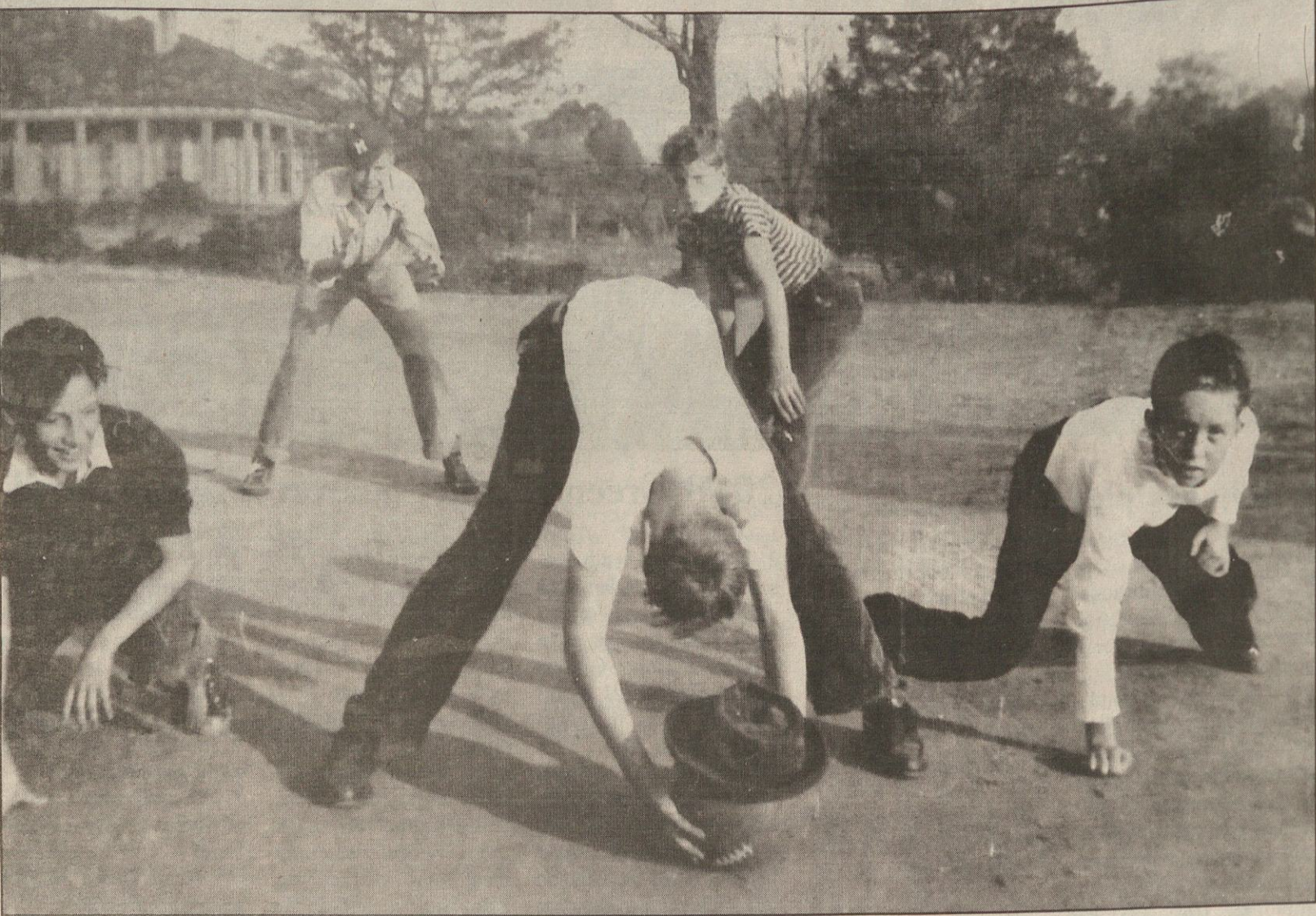

War Ration Book (below)

This World War II War Ration Book was found in some trash and brought by the office by Ms. Barbara "Gann" Mock. It belonged to her great-grandpa George Stacy and her grandpa Clee Gann.. They had to have these stamps to buy sugar and coffee and other necessities during the war years. Her family was raised in Prentiss County. The certificate of registrar read: This is to certify that pursuant to the Rationing orders and regulations administered by the OFFICE OF PRICE ADMINISTRATION, an agency of the United States Government, Stacy, George W., New Site, Prentiss, Miss., 5 ft 7 in, 160 lbs, blue eyes, grey hair, 86 years male has been issued the attached Ration Stamps this 6th day of May, 1942, upon the basis of an application signed by his agent, Clee Gann. Signed Mrs. T. P. Stephens, Local Board No. 59, Prentiss, County, Mississippi.

The Stamps contained in this Book are valid only after the lawful holder of this Book has signed the certificate below, and are void if detached contrary to the Regulations. (A father, mother, or guardian may sign the name of a person under 18.) In case of questions, difficulties, or complaints, consult your local Ration Board.

**Certificate of Book Holder**

# The Battle Of Armageddon

Perhaps no battle mentioned in the Bible has been the subject of more conversation and conjecture than the battle of Armageddon. It is interesting that we just finished with the Marriage of Christ and the church, and now we are into a "negative subject" that speaks about death and destruction. It may come as a surprise to some people, but those who study the whole Bible will not be surprised, to learn that Scripture probably says much more negative stuff than positive! I just finished reading through several prophetic books of the Bible, as I do on a regular basis, and I noticed in this reading that the prophets had much to say about God's judgment against sin. I wonder why modern preachers and

those who think they are prophets do not major on these themes, since the world today is at least as sinful as the world of the prophets' times. I would much rather write, preach and teach about heaven, but the sad note is that most people will not be in heaven, thus the need of our day, and any day, is to warn the unsaved, as well as to console believers when needed, that the world is headed for judgment. In our present chapter of Revelation, one form of God's judgment is

the battle of Armageddon in Revelation.

Revelation 19:11-13 says, "And I saw heaven opened, and behold a white horse; and He that sat upon him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He doth judge and make war. His eyes were as a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns; and He had a name written that no man knew, but He Himself. And He was clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and His name is called The Word of God."

John the apostle, who wrote the Book of Revelation, is seeing a vision, and in this vision he sees one sitting upon a white horse. The context here shows clearly that this is Jesus, who once rode into Jerusalem on a donkey, but is here coming back to earth on a white horse. The horse was an animal used in battle; whereas the donkey on which Jesus rode into Jerusalem almost two thousand years ago was an animal symbolizing peace. The Lord Jesus is not coming at this point in time to call for repentance or to heal the sick; He is coming to judge and make war. He is called Faithful and True, because the judgment He is about to execute is in accordance with the plan and will of God. He will make war

in righteousness, whereas most wars started by men are not "righteous wars". Those who think that God is all about love, forgiveness, acceptance etc. need to pay close attention to our passage. Yes, God is a God of all of the things I mention here, but there will be a time when it is too late for any of these, at least for those who have followed their own ways and rejected God and His way!

The eyes of the Lord Jesus, at this point in time, will not be filled with compassion on the unsaved, rather they will be like a flame of fire, symbolizing judgment. (Have you noticed that the "all positive preachers" never cover subjects like the one before us?) There are many crowns on the head of

the Lord Jesus when comes back to whip battle of Armageddon. Some of these crowns evidently be those that laid at the feet of Jesus the saved who have won them in this life (Revelation 4:10). The name Jesus has here is one that only He knows, perhaps because it is a special name given to Him for a particular battle, but this is conjecture, for no one really knows this or why it is given, except God. The clothing of Jesus is "dipped in blood," showing that the battle is about to whip will be a battle of human blood shed. Revelation 14:14 gives us a preview of a battle of Armageddon and Revelation 16:16 gives us the name "Armageddon" for this battle.
