# Traxys Cometals Processing, Inc., Locating at Northeast Mississippi's Yellow Creek Port, Creating 25 Jobs

Jackson, Miss. (Dec. 13, 2018) - Traxys Cometals Processing, Inc., is locating operations in Burnsville, Miss., at the Yellow Creek Port. The project is a \$10 million corporate investment and will create 25 jobs.

Traxys Cometals Processing is a part of Traxys North America, a metals marketing, distribution and trading company. The company is constructing a new facility consisting of 105,000-square-feet of manufacturing space, as well as office space. There, Traxys Cometals will produce alloying agents for the molten metal treatment of aluminum and steel.

"The Traxys Group is very excited about this first investment in Mississippi, and we are confident it will lead to additional growth opportunities in the not too distant future," Traxys group CEO Mark Kristoff and Traxys Cometals SVP Ryan Campbell said. "Officials at all levels worked closely with our team throughout the process, and the tremendous support from state, local and county levels was central in our decision to select Tishomingo County."

This investment will allow Traxys to better serve customers with products made in the U.S. and build on a strong track record of supplier and customer

The Mississippi Development Authority is providing assistance for the purchase of equipment and building construction. The Yellow Creek Port is financing construction of the facility. Tishomingo County Development Foundation is providing ad valorem and Free Port Warehouse tax exemptions.



seven churches in Revelation chapters two and three show the Words of Christ being given to the angels, meaning the pastors, of these churches. Jesus not only

sent His angels (also meaning messengers), whether the pastors of the churches, John the apostle, or a spirit being, to the churches. All of these "messengers" are seen giving information to John in the Book of Revelation, either by the announced judgments

by some angels, or by the messages in words that others gave. The big point is that the Lord Jesus Christ gave the information in the Book of Revelation to the lo-Those cal churches. who think that the only requirement God makes of believers is that they believe individually and live their lives without being a part of any local church are missing the very point that is being made in our verses. Certainly Christ deals with Christians individually, but that is certainly not the only way He deals with us, for He intends that every believer be a part of a local church, for fellowship, discipline and discipleship. Since Jesus sent His messenger

(angel) to testify these things in the churches, those who are not in local churches do not have Revelation addressed directly to them as individuals. Yes, they can learn for it as individuals, but the fellowship with a local church will certainly enhance their learning, because all of us together are likely to know more about the Word of God than any one of us knows on our own. Now for a bit of encouragement to the local churches we will consider that the Book of Revelation was given as a testimony of Jesus to the churches, thus the churches that do not "get into the Book of Revelation" are missing something that Jesus addressed to them. I grew

up in a society where many people, even some preachers, said, out of the Book of Rev elation; it is a closed book." May I ask why Je sus would specifically saw that He was testifying to the churches in this book and then say, "But you cannot read My letter in you, for it is a closed let. ter." Does that make any sense to you dear reader I should think not, and certainly does not make any sense to me, much less to the Lord Jesus Himself. So, get into the Book of Revelation and see what Jesus has said in it to you and your h. cal church!
