

Two Belmont Men Arrested For Warrants and then Charged with Possession

On December 5th Tishomingo County Sheriff's deputies conducted a traffic stop on Hwy 25 in the Tishomingo area for Careless Driving and Improper Equipment. Christopher Alan Whitfield and Joshua Shea Scott were both arrested with warrants and the charged with possession.

During the traffic stop, deputies learned that both the driver and passenger had outstanding misdemeanor warrants for their arrest. As the deputies were arresting the men, a search of the vehicle yielded some alleged methamphetamine, which was found in a hidden compartment of the vehicle. The deputies transported both Whitfield and Scott to the Tishomingo County Jail.

39-year-old, white male of 40 Yarber Street Belmont, Mississippi was also officially charged with the felony possession of controlled substance (methamphetamine). Scott's bond was set by the Justice Court in the amount of \$2,500. Scott also had a fail to appear warrant issued through the Justice Court of Tishomingo County.

Tishomingo County Sheriff's Department to Participate in the Drive Sober or Get Pulled Over Christmas/New Year's Champaign

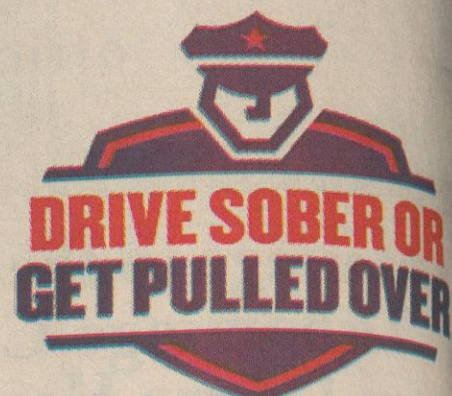

Daugherty "It is vital that we keep our roads and traveler's safe, not just at the holidays, but every day. During this holiday, we will likely see a rise in drunk driving. We'll be arresting anyone who breaks

this life-saving law.

With today's options for getting home safely, there's no excuse for getting behind the wheel impaired as it endangers you and everyone else around you. Law enforcement recommends these safe alternatives to impaired driving: Designate, or be, a sober driver, or download the SaferRide



mobile app. If you see a drunk driver on the road, contact 911 or the Tishomingo County Sheriff's Office at 662-423-7000. Remember, it is never safe to drink and drive.

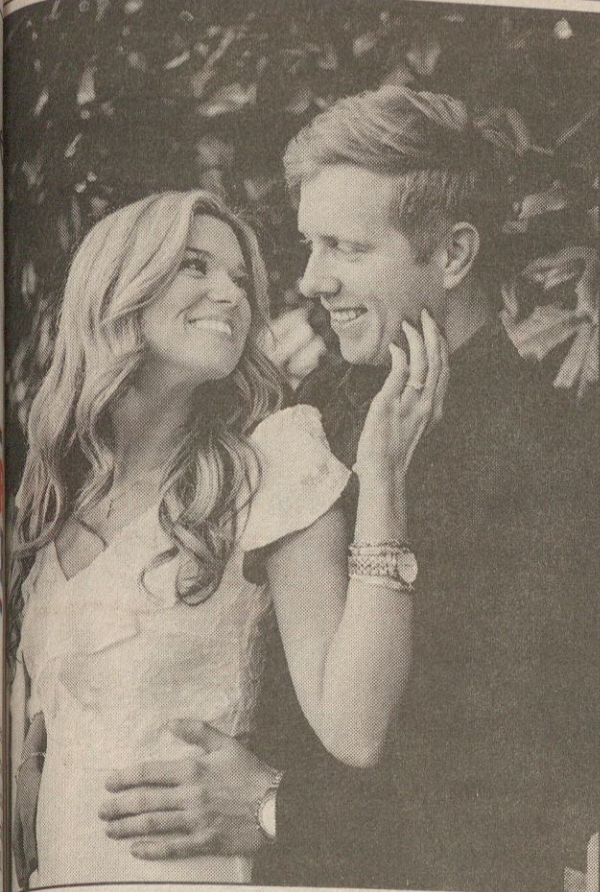

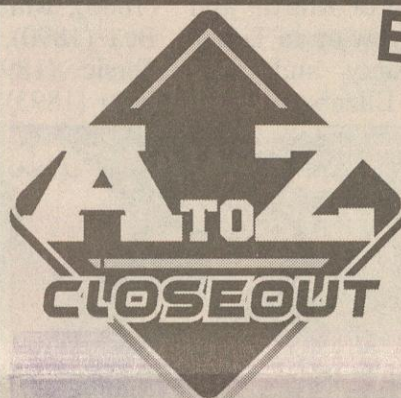

The Jacob Wilson Phifer Family

(This information is taken from the Tishomingo County Families Book and was submitted by Myra Hunkapiller.)

Jacob Wilson Phifer, born February 22, 1851 was

the son of Martin Wyler (Wiley) Phifer and Lydia Gaultney. Wilson was one of five children of Martin and Lydia. He grew up in Tishomingo County and married Mary Elizabeth John-

son (born July 19, 1933). To this union were born 12 children: Eller (1885), Mae (1886), Matt (1888), Laura Bea (1890), Mollie (1891), Tersie (1892), John William (1893), Leona (1895),

Modena (1897), James R. (1898), Amanda (1899, and Sarah (1901).

Eller married Willie Bryant. Mae married Charles Barnes. Laura Bee married Raymond Belue. Mollie married Claud Carpenter. Tersie married Robert McCoy. John William married Pearl Carpenter. Leona married Thomas McCoy. Modena married Houston McCoy. James R. married Ester Tennon. Amanda married Auston McCoy and after his death married Shelby Morgan. Sarah married Otis McCoy.

Wilson and Mary Beth "Elizabeth" and their 12 children made their home near where Shady Grove Church is today. They are buried at Forked Oak, Prentiss County.

Phifer Family in Tishomingo County

According to research by Brenda Phifer Whitfield, in 1772, Hans Jacob Pfeifer (lace maker) and his family of Hafelfingen, situated in the township of Homburg,

are among the list of Swiss emigrants in the 18th Century who immigrated to America. The family he brought with him included his third wife, Anna Margaretha Schafner, and their children: Anna, Catherina, Matthias and Salome. They settled in North Carolina. All of the Phifer family who reside in Tishomingo County came from this line. Matthias married Leah Sarah Wiley on November 20, 1790; their son Martin Wiley Phifer migrated to Old Tishomingo County and married Lydia Gortney (Gaultney). They settled in the Holcut Community. Martin is buried on land that belonged to Sebron Gentles and Lydia is buried at Forked Oak. They were the parents of Jacob Wilson (family photo and history above), James Monroe, Mary, William M. and Amanda.

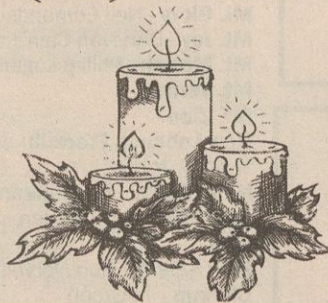

Scenes From The Last Chapter In The Bible (part XI)

It is interesting to notice Who is giving the information in the Book of Revelation. Revelation 22:16 says, "I Jesus have sent Mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, and the bright and morning star." If you remember our coverage of Revelation chapters two and three, you will note that every one of the letters written to the seven churches starts with a description of Jesus Christ as the speaker, and every one of these seven letters ends with the words: "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches." It should not be hard to conclude that the Father, Son and Holy Spirit are

one God! If both Jesus and the Spirit are speaking to the churches, and Jesus came to reveal God, as John 1:18 says, then there are three persons in the Godhead. Here is John 1:18: "No man hath seen God at any time; the only begotten Son, Which is in the bosom of the Father, He hath declared Him." Revelation 22:16 says Jesus has sent His angel to testify to the churches, and every one of the seven letters to the

seven churches in Revelation chapters two and three show the Words of Christ being given to the angels, meaning the pastors, of these churches.

Jesus not only sent His angels (also meaning messengers), whether the pastors of the churches, John the apostle, or a spirit being, to the churches. All of these "messengers" are seen giving information to John in the Book of Revelation, either by the judgments announced

by some angels, or by the messages in words that others gave. The big point is that the Lord Jesus Christ gave the information in the Book of Revelation to the local churches. Those who think that the only requirement God makes of believers is that they believe individually and live their lives without being a part of any local church are missing the very point that is being made in our verses. Certainly Christ deals with Christians individually, but that is certainly not the only way He deals with us, for He intends that every believer be a part of a local church, for fellowship, discipline and discipleship. Since Jesus sent His messenger

(angel) to testify these things in the churches, those who are not in local churches do not have Revelation addressed directly to them as individuals. Yes, they can learn for it as individuals, but the fellowship with a local church will certainly enhance their learning, because all of us together are likely to know more about the Word of God than any one of us knows on our own. Now for a bit of encouragement to the local churches we will consider that the Book of Revelation was given as a testimony of Jesus to the churches, thus the churches that do not "get into the Book of Revelation" are missing something that Jesus addressed to them. I grew

up in a society where many people, even some preachers, said, "Stay out of the Book of Revelation; it is a closed book." May I ask why Jesus would specifically say that He was testifying to the churches in this book and then say, "But you cannot read My letter to you, for it is a closed letter." Does that make any sense to you dear reader? I should think not, and it certainly does not make any sense to me, much less to the Lord Jesus Himself. So, get into the Book of Revelation and see what Jesus has said in it to you and your local church!

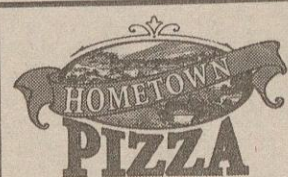

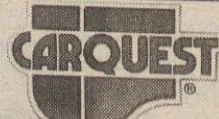

We were again able to offer the Crock-pot cooking class to help teach

A new program just started this year. With the help of the Northeast MS Community Services bus service "The Pantry" will be able to offer travel to "The Pantry" twice a month: the second Monday and the third Thursday of each month.

With the start of the New Year, all clients will need to requalify with their first visit of the new year. And with the start of a new year, we are pleased, with your help, to continue to help our friends, family & neighbors.
