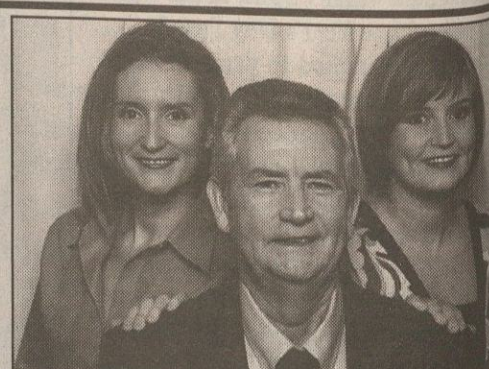

## Don't Be Fooled by Terrorists

Iran seemed to intentionally avoid killing Americans in their recent airstrike against our American military base in Iraq. Reports indicate it was more about «saving face» with their own people after the killing of their General Qassem Soleimani. Don't be fooled.

Iran does not want to be friends and has proven it over the years by their support of terroristic groups. Look for them to try to utilize some terror group to blindsides us with something very destructive. They know they do not want a war with the United States and will try to hide behind someone else.

In 1998 Fazul Abdullah Mohammed and Abdullah Ahmed Abdullah were credited with being the masterminds behind the embassies in Nairobi, Kenya and Dar es Salaam, Tanzania that killed over 200 people and injured over 5000 more. Twelve Americans were killed in those bombings. The FBI would track sixty phone calls placed on a satellite phone by Osama bin Laden from the small country of Azerbaijan to his associates in the country's capital of Baku. Bin Laden would be placed on the FBI's top ten wanted list as a result of these attacks on our two African embassies.

In 2000 the USS Cole was bombed in Yemen. Seventeen U.S. Navy sailors were killed and 39 injured in the deadliest attack against a United States naval vessel since the USS Stark incident in 1987. The organization al-Qaeda and Osama bin Laden claimed responsibility for the attack. Many names and multiple people were involved in this attack. Bin Laden like Iran used people to do his dirty work.

September 11, 2001 - The deadliest terrorist attack in US history took place when 19 men hijacked four US commercial airliners. The plot was orchestrated by al Qaeda leader Osama bin Laden. A total of 2,977 people were killed at the World Trade Center in New York; at the Pentagon in Washington, DC; and in Shanksville, Pennsylvania.

Gen. Qassem Soleimani led the elite Quds Force, part of Iran's Revolutionary Guards that reports to Ayatollah Ali Khamenei. Soleimani was also accused of controlling proxy militias across the Middle East including ones in Iraq, Lebanon and Syria. He has been called a murderer by several of our U.S. officials. The Pentagon blamed Soleimani for a series of attacks on allied bases in Iraq in recent months, including a rocket strike that killed a U.S. contractor and wounded four other service members. The Pentagon also has said Soleimani had been actively developing plans to attack U.S. diplomats and service members in Iraq and elsewhere throughout the region. The Quds, which he led, were designated a foreign terrorist organization by the U.S. and were considered the most powerful intelligence operative in the Middle East, for many years.

While none of us want killing, President Trump did the right thing. If bin Laden could have been taken out before the African bombings or before September 11, 2001 thousands of lives could have been saved. Soleimani was on the move to see who, how and what he could organize to strike again.

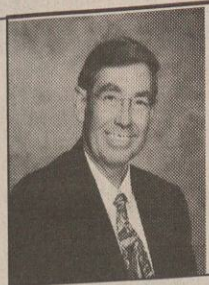


# Words From The Wisest King Before Jesus (part 48)

I love the Book of Ecclesiastes, which many Bible scholars believe to have been written by Solomon, and I concur with that, mainly because of what chapter one says about the writer. Whoever wrote the book, it is inspired by the Lord, and that is the important thing. Ecclesiastes 8:12-13 says, "Though a sinner do evil an hundred times, and his days be prolonged, yet surely I know that it shall be well with them that fear God, which fear before Him: But it shall not be well with the wicked, neither shall he prolong his days, which are as a shadow; because he feareth not before

God." These verses have some much needed information, because they say that men are not getting away with sin, and also that the righteous will be blessed. Sometimes those who sin come to a place of hardness toward sin, because no immediate judgment falls on them for their wrong. Solomon says that one may commit evil a hundred times; he may live a long life, but it will not finally be

well for him. Humanity is interesting on this point, for many seem to think that the righteous fare no better than the wicked. The faultiness of this reasoning lies in the fact that we have not met God yet! It is not always hard to get by with breaking the laws of the land, but no one is getting by with disobeying God. Yes, one may repent and be forgiven, but all who die without forgiveness will face an angry

Judge.

Solomon says that he knows that it will be well with those who fear God. If we look at the situation in the world, with the persecution of Christians in much of the world, we might wonder about this statement from Solomon. If we can see, however, beyond the present and take the Bible's testimony about the future, we know that it will finally be well for all who know God. We say in verse 12 that the days of a sinner may be prolonged, then verse 13 says that the sinner cannot prolong his days. The idea is that the sinner may live to

be old, but when the time comes for him to die, he cannot prolong his days. I have heard about rich, ungodly people who have offered large sums of money to doctors, if those doctors could give one more day of life, but that cannot be done when God says: "It is time to die". Our writer says that it will not be well with the wicked, meaning that when he dies and faces God in judgment the sentence will not be avoidable! The fear of God is mentioned in our verses, because that fear, meaning a right respect for Him and His Word, will keep us from following a life

of sin. It is the fear of God that is missing from the lives of all who follow their own desires and disregard God's Word. It is never to presume that one can get saved just before he dies, for it is not be that his mind is working properly or it may not be the Spirit of God is drawing him to salvation at that time. It is a poor judgment for a person to put off the need for salvation to reject the Holy Spirit's drawing of them toward repentance!

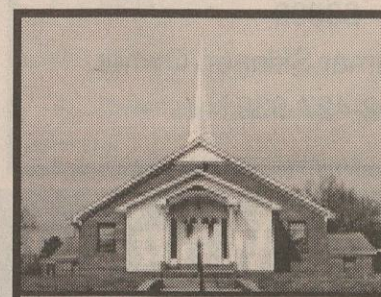

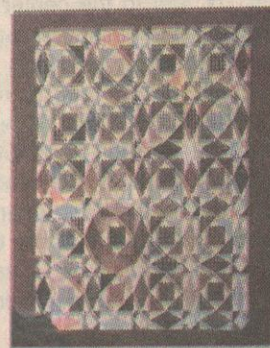

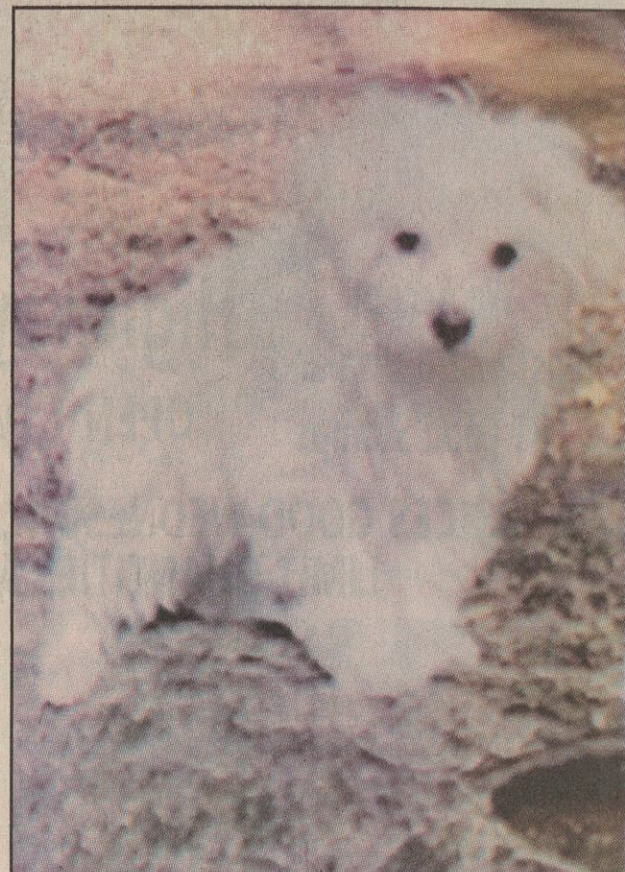

# Charlotte's Attic Iuka Presbyterian Church

This article and photo were found in our old files (June 1970). Since that time the Presbyterian Church located on Eastport Street has been sold several times and is now a private residence. The church in this photo was located on south Main Street just over the railroad tracks from Jaybird Park. I first noticed this church in an old photo taken from the old Tishomingo County Courthouse before it burned. I was not aware of a church located south of the tracks until it was seen on that photo.

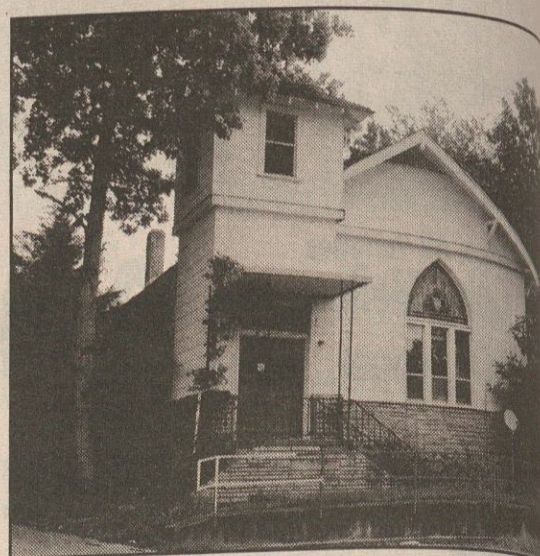

The first notice of the proposed building of a Presbyterian Church in Iuka came in the minutes of the Chickasaw Presbytery of the Memphis Synod in 1872. Thus, a meeting of the Iuka Presbyterian Church was held in Courtland, Ala. This was the initial planning of the church which was built that year. The church was built through the efforts of Mrs. Mary Lecky of Courtland, Ala., who moving to Iuka in July, 1865, found a few here

of like faith. Sunday School was held in the Mayor's Office and the church was formed almost entirely of women. The Iuka Church, which in the early days was called The Mary Lecky Church, as verified by all books in the library, was composed of pioneers, some of them dating their church affiliations back to the Scotch Covenanters. The frame church was erected through the efforts of that small band of women on the south side of town but builders were unfortunate on account of lack of funds in their choice of a location. The church was built on the ditch bank near the present home of Mrs. Lucy (Jourdan) Roane. The branch over flowed, destroying the foundation many times each year. In 1908, J. C. Gracey, an elder, donated land on the north side of town and the church was put on rollers and moved to the present location. Messrs. Clifton Reid, Houston Mars and A. W. Mangum are among the older citizens who remember seeing this move take place. Sunday School was held in the church but it was

damaged in the new church was 1924, but due to construction this 1954 to make room for the present building (Eastport Street), with original building designed by a famous architect, Mr. Broceley, and was built like an Episcopal a Presbyterian but with its tall fry tower, the ceiling would be a thing of beauty and Mrs. Wayne moved to Iuka years later and the structure in state of dilapidation due to faulty engineering.
