The Circuit Clerk's Office would like to remind everyone who may have questions about Elections to contact at 423-7026, and provide overview of Upcoming Elections in 2022. Party Primary Elections will be conducted for the United States House of Representative on Tuesday, June 7th, 2022. To qualify for U.S. House of Representatives as a political-party candidate you must file with the respective State Party Executive Committee, pay a fee of \$500.00 to the respective party. If quali-

fying as an independent candidate you must file your paper work with the Mississippi Secretary of State, complete signature petitions with 200 qualified electors of the Congressional district, and have the signatures certified by the Circuit Clerk of the County in which the signatures were collected. The qualifying period for U.S. Representative begins on January 3, 2022 and ends on March 1, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. A candidate for

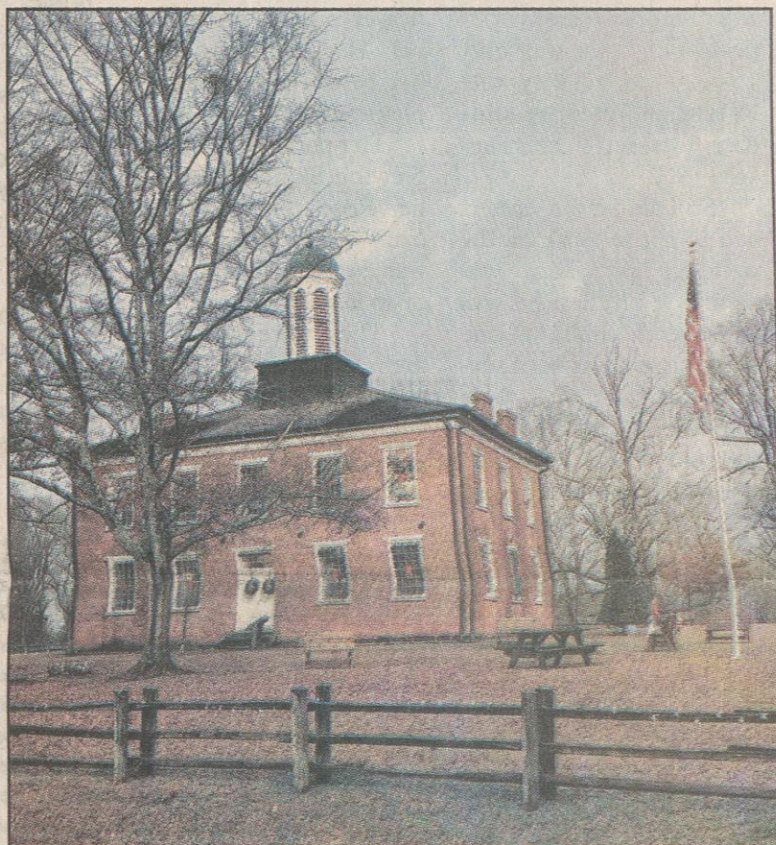


The Jacinto Foundation Receives \$250,000 Grant from State

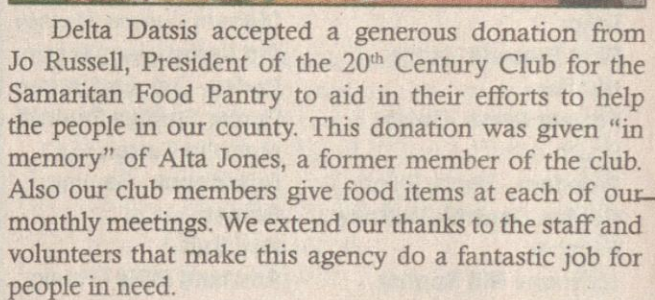

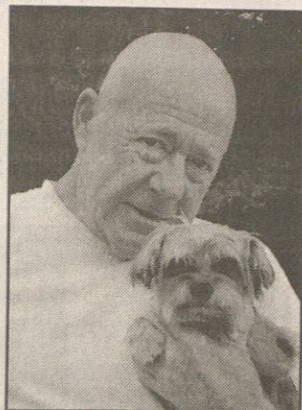

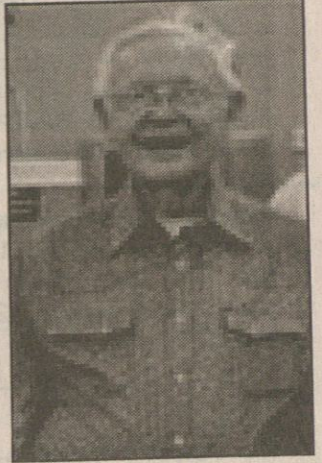
Walter Wynn
