

First the blocks were framed together, then sewn together to make the quilt-top, then a thin layer of cotton batten and last a piece or two of material for the backside. This was pinned together and finally placed on the quilting frame. "Oh what a joy to make our brother this quilt" exclaimed Ludie, and Julie nodded her head in agreement. Georgia sat down beside the frame and chose her spot to start sewing. Soon Ludie, Sarah, and Artie joined her. Then quickly, mother, Mary, and Julie sat down. Vonie waited till little Artie grew

On February 16th 1902 the young couple was married. They were delighted with their gift (the quilt). They moved in the home with his parents. The men planned to farm together. On the day of the wedding Tom dressed in his suit, clean ironed shirt, tie and a boutonniere on his coat lapel and put his watch in his pocket and chain in place. He was a young handsome man, sitting in a chair. Lula stood beside him. She was a young beautiful bride. She dressed in a skirt, lovely blouse and jacket with a flower pinned on the lapel. Her fan hangs from her belt. They pose for a picture. We treasure it!

Her parents were Isaac Newton Skinner and Willie Rose Flynt Skinner from Iuka, MS. was 1/4 American Indian, or so it was said.

U.S. House of Representatives must be a resident of the State of Mississippi as of the date of his/her election to office, a qualified elector of the district, be the age of twenty-five (25), and been a citizen of the United States for seven years.

In the 2022 election year the only County wide/district office on the ballot will be the 2nd district Tishomingo County School Board Member. The 2nd District School Board Member election is non-partisan, and will be conducted on November 8, 2022. The qualifying period for school board begins on August 10, 2022 and ends on September 9, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. Candidates must file with the Circuit Clerk the proper paper work, with a petition signed by fifty (50) qualified electors of the district for which election is sought. All petition signatures must be verified by the Circuit Clerk. Candidates for School Board must be a bona fide resident and qualified elector (registered voter) of the district in which election is sought, and have a high school diploma or its

equivalent.

The Mississippi Court of Appeals Judges, Circuit Judges, and Chancery Judges will be on the ballot in November of 2022 and is a non-partisan race. The qualifying period for Appeals Court Judges, Circuit Judges, and Chancery judges will begin on January 3, 2022 and end on February 1, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. To qualify you must file the proper paper work with the Mississippi Secretary of State and pay the following fee; Appeals Court Judge \$200.00, Circuit and Chancery Judges \$100.00. A candidate for Court of Appeals Judge must be a qualified elector of the State of Mississippi, the district, county or county district of the office for which the candidate seeks election. The candidate must be at least thirty (30) years of age, a practicing attorney, and a citizen of the state for five (5) years preceding the day of election. A candidate for Circuit or Chancery Judge must be a qualified elector of the district, county or county district of the office for which the candidate seeks election, at least twenty-six years

As of December 27th 2021, 4082 people have been diagnosed in the county, and 535,258 individuals have been diagnosed statewide since 2019. Since the onset of the pandemic Tishomingo County has lost 97 residents to COVID-19, while a total of 10,420 individuals have died from the virus in Missis-


